OVERVIEW

Thurston County Community Planning encouraged residents to take a survey and share their thoughts on what's most important to them over the next 20 years. This feedback is one of the first steps in the multi-year review of the county's comprehensive plan.

The results of this survey will inform the comprehensive plan update process over the next two years.

METHODS

The survey included five short-answer questions and three demographic questions. The complete results are available by request.

Outreach for the survey included:


- Survey and flyer were translated into Spanish, Vietnamese, and Korean.


WHO TOOK THE SURVEY

553 people submitted the survey from across Thurston County. 97% of respondants selected English as the primary language in their houshold. 13 selected Spanish, and 2 selected Other.



BoCC review & action. Outreach to explain how to formally comment at public hearings.
