Random Check of Ballots

Per RCW 29A.60.170(4) a random audit of batches is required. The political party observer coordinators requested the required audit of ballots be conducted for Puyallup School District Prop. 1. Our system uses up to five digital scanners and one central count server. On February 13, 2025, a random batch from each scanner used in the election was drawn, hand tallied, and compared to the machine report. All results of the hand tally for the chosen race matched the machine report.
