HABITAT, MULCH & NATIVES



Track 1: Mulching Rainscaper

- Balance soil pH.
- Increase native plants.
- Use eco-lawn seed blend.
- Mulch with on-site materials like leaves, grass clippings.
- Mulch with chip drop from local arborists or untreated bark or straw.
- No mow or mulch mow.
- Keep minimal lawn.
- Protect stormwater system.

Estimated Cost & Effort:
Low-Medium

Track 2: EcoPro Landscaper

- Balance soil pH.
- Use Natural Lawn Care practices like slow-release fertilizer, aeration, mulch mowing, smart watering, hand pulling weeds, over-seeding & topdressing with compost and mulch.
- Use of slow-release fertilizer.
- Manage stockpiles & materials to protect stormwater system.

Estimated Cost & Effort:
Medium

Track 3: Green Lawn Grower

- Balance soil pH.
- Use Natural Lawn Care practices like slow-release fertilizer, aeration, mulch mowing, smart watering, hand pulling weeds, over-seeding & topdressing with compost.
- Use of slow-release fertilizer.
- Mulch & increase native plants.
- Protect stormwater system.

Estimated Cost & Effort:
Medium-High
