Principal/ CPI team	-Student Conduct Report to principal  Offenses include but are not limited to Cheating/Plagiarism, Computer/Telecommunication/Network Infraction, Dangerous Objects, Destruction of Property, Fighting, Harassment/Hazing/Bullying, Physical Assault, Theft, Threats/Intimidation, Verbal Abuse, and Weapons Possession Actions include but are not limited to informal talk or formal conference with school official, parental involvement, removal from class, detention, and in/out-of-school suspension
