Rosy Rubio Scholarship Nomination/Application Criteria As Supported by The Rosy Rubio Scholarship Endowment

PURPOSE:

To provide support to financially deserving, currently non-certified Arizona public school employees who demonstrate a strong commitment to becoming a teacher in Arizona rural schools, a strong work ethic, and leadership qualities.

QUALITIES

To be considered applicants must:

- Be a current employee of an Arizona Rural Schools Association member district.
- Be an Arizona resident, and express a commitment to teach in rural Arizona.
- Be enrolled, full or part-time, in an Arizona college or university teacher preparation program.
- Be a first-time teacher certification candidate.
- Students in five-plus year programs leading to a master's degree may apply for the first four undergraduate years of their program.

ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS

To be considered applicants must:

- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Be enrolled in a course of study leading to a K-12 Arizona teaching certificate.

FINANCIAL NEED

Otherwise qualifying applicants must demonstrate one of the following:

- An EFC (Expected Family Contribution) from the FAFSA report which is \$10,000 or less.
- A low to moderate Adjusted Gross Income (AGI).

Description of extenuating financial circumstance provided by the applicant.

AWARD AMOUNT

This award will be \$1,000 annually for four years, until completion of a qualifying teacher certification program, or withdrawal from a qualifying teacher education program, whichever comes first.

No later than August 31 of each award year, applicant must provide Arizona Rural Schools Association documented proof of enrollment at:
