Please note:

- There is no cost for parking and the first parking decal. Additional decals for a 2nd or 3rd vehicle will cost \$5 each.
- All debts must be cleared before a parking permit will be issued.
- Application packets must be returned to the Registrar. Other staff or office personnel will not accept packets.
- All students must remain in good standing or risk having their parking privileges suspended or revoked. (GPA/Attendance/Discipline)
- Applications and no parking permits will not be assigned over the summer.

STUDENT PARKING REGULATIONS

****Only students who complete an application and receive a permit are permitted to park on campus****

Students may only park in the assigned student parking area.

1. Parking permits must be properly displayed (hanging on rear view mirror) in the vehicle for which it is assigned.
2. A student may not give, sell, or loan his/her parking permit to another student, including siblings. This will result in the revocation of both students parking privileges.
3. There is a \$5.00 replacement fee for a lost, stolen or mutilated parking permit.
4. Between 6:30 am and 4:00 pm students must park in the student lot. The staff lot is off limits to students. Parking in these non-designated lots will result in a suspension of parking privileges or other disciplinary action.
5. Students must follow proper sign-out procedures when leaving early. Due to Covid: NO LUNCH OFF CAMPUS PASSES.
6. Displaying a permit in a vehicle other than the one assigned to that space may result in suspension or revocation of parking privileges.
7. Students who lose parking privileges due to discipline or poor standing will not receive a refund for additional permits.
8. NO LOITERING in the parking lots, in or out of the vehicle.
9. Searches of vehicles will take place whenever a school official has reasonable suspicion to believe that illegal drugs, alcohol, weapons or unauthorized person/persons are contained within the vehicle.
10. All accidents in the parking lot or on campus must be reported IMMEDIATELY to security and an incident report must be filed.
11. Students who park in the lot may not go to their vehicle or be in the lot during school hours. THIS INCLUDES LUNCH AND BETWEEN CLASSES. Violations will result in suspension of your parking privileges. There will be NO warning for first time offense.
12. Park at your own risk. Monument Valley High School and/or its personnel are not responsible for personal property, theft, loss or damage to vehicles and property.
13. No derogatory stickers, drawings, or writing are allowed to be displayed on vehicles.
14. When an alternate vehicle is driven to school, the student must notify MVHS Admin before parking. Failure to do so may result in suspension of parking privileges.

STUDENTS MAY BE SUSPENDED OR LOSE PARKING PRIVILEGES FROM THE LOT FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- Parking an alternate vehicle in the lot without notifying security.
- No parking permit.
- Students in poor standing (suspension or loss of parking due to behavioral discipline and/or academic failures will be determined on an individual basis, pending administrative review).
- Parking in the staff lot.
- Failure to respond to a parking citation within twenty-four (24) hours.
- Excessive speed, squealing tires, passing other vehicles, driving over curbs, driving in the bus lane, or any other unsafe driving practices.
- Leaving campus in a vehicle with other students without proper authorization.
- Failure to show proper ID and/or a written pass when leaving campus.
- Parking anywhere other than in the assigned parking lot.
- Failure to comply with the request of school or security personnel.
- Tardiness, absences, or failure to follow parking lot rules.
- Parking in handicap spaces or fire lanes.
- Derogatory stickers, drawings, or writing displayed on vehicle.
- Leaving campus during lunch without permission.

VIOLATIONS

The following are consequences for each parking violation and will be tracked throughout the year.

- 1st – Administrative conference with parent/guardian and student.
- 2nd – Result in suspension of student bringing a vehicle for 5 days.
- 3rd – The vehicle will be immediately towed. The owner of the vehicle will be responsible for all fees incurred by the towing company. Permit will be revoked.

* PLEASE NOTE: The school assumes NO RESPONSIBILITY for damage or theft of student property. The school will assist in any investigation required, but all parking is the student's/parent's own risk.
