

Timeline to Starting a Degree Program

The process from choosing a program to applying and enrolling in a **bachelor's or master's degree program** can take anywhere from **6–8 weeks**, depending on how quickly you complete your application and submit required materials.

It's never too early—or too late—to begin your education journey.



Day 1

Visit your organization's education program page to learn more about the learning opportunities available to you.

Ready to get started?

Select your program and submit your information to get connected to your academic institution of choice.

Not sure what you want to study?

No problem! You can always change your mind. Select a program you think you may be interested in and an Enrollment Coach can help you confirm which program is right for you.

Days 5–10

Connect with an Enrollment Coach and begin your application. Request your transcripts from previous institutions.

Here are some sample questions you might want to ask your Enrollment Coach:

- What program should I choose based on my goals?
- Can you explain how my organization's scholarship works? For example, how is the tuition coverage applied? Will I be responsible for covering any of my education costs?
- Can you help me figure out how many of my prior credits will transfer?

Day 40

Complete your application including all required materials.

Your application will not be completed without the following items:

- Transcripts
- FAFSA © (if required)

Day 60

Receive your admissions decision.

Not Admitted?

If you're not admitted, there may be alternate pathways or conditional admission options available. You can also consider applying to a different program.

Enroll

Enroll in courses. Connect with an Academic Advisor for guidance on which courses to take.

Tuition and Fees:

Take the proper steps to ensure your organization's scholarship gets applied to your tuition and be sure to double check your student bill to confirm the scholarship was applied.
