

Articulation Agreement

between

Pacific Bible College and Multnomah University

Multnomah University (MU) and Pacific Bible College (PBC) agree that students, who choose to enter Multnomah University should be provided with a smooth curriculum transition that minimizes loss of credit and duplication of coursework. Therefore, Multnomah University and Pacific Bible College agree to enter into this curriculum articulation agreement.

It is to be understood that credits earned at Pacific Bible College will be accepted by Multnomah University as they are deemed appropriate to the various program and general education requirements. Transfer students must complete a minimum of 32 semester credits (one full year of resident study) in residence at Multnomah University and must complete a minimum of 15 semester hours in their major at Multnomah as a requirement for the B.A. degree awarded by Multnomah University.

It is also understood that a student who has earned a bachelor's degree from Pacific Bible College is eligible to apply for admission into any of the Master's programs offered by Multnomah University and has the pre-requisite undergraduate degree completed.

Both institutions enter into this agreement as cooperating, equal partners who shall maintain the integrity of their separate programs.

This agreement became effective May 26, 2015. The agreement is being renewed for another five year term and will be in effect until August 1, 2025. The agreement will be reviewed at the conclusion of the five years and may be renewed at that time. The agreement may be voided by mutual consent or by either party with 3 months notice.

We the representatives of Pacific Bible College and Multnomah University agree to the terms of this agreement.
