



## **Full Time Faculty, Business Program; Assistant/Associate Professor of Business**

**Position Description:** Candidates will be expected to teach undergraduate courses in both online and face-to-face modalities. The candidate must be able to teach in at least three of the following areas: business administration, economics, accounting, finance, project management, business ethics, global business, or business technology. Candidates will be expected to work closely with the Program Chair to build and grow the business program, which is relatively new, and to build connections between the university and the business community. Student advising, chapel attendance, and participation in faculty/student collaboration opportunities, such as clubs and corporate visits, is also expected.

**Minimum Requirements:** A strong interest in undergraduate teaching is required. Candidates must have earned an MBA in a business or a related field and must have experience teaching business at an undergraduate level. Ph.D. or DBA in a business field is strongly preferred. Relevant professional work experience in business and industry is essential. Support of the mission of Multnomah University and agreement with MU's doctrinal statement is required.

The successful candidate will:

- Provide excellent teaching to undergraduate students in a variety of delivery formats;
- Actively integrate the Christian faith in teaching;
- Have relevant work experience in business to bring real-world experience into the classroom;
- Engage in service to the university and community;
- Actively build connections for students into the business community
