SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

Multnomah is pleased to offer the Ione (Widing) Winquist Memorial Scholarship to new or returning Portland Campus students who are pursuing a degree in ministry and plan to serve in full-time missions overseas.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Submit a FAFSA for the 2021-22 award year (include Multnomah school code: 003206)
- 2. Submit a 1-2 page essay response (include your full name and student ID at the top of the page):
 - Please detail your vocational goals, call to ministry, and milestone accomplishments that set you apart from your peers.
- 3. Submit your essay response to <u>finaid@multnomah.edu</u>.

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

Students who meet the following requirements are eligible to apply:

- Incoming or returning full-time Portland Campus students admitted to any Multnomah University
 Undergraduate or Graduate program pursuing full-time ministry, with preference going to those pursuing
 full-time overseas missions or ministry work
- 2. A completed FAFSA with Multnomah's school code (003206) (www.fafsa.gov)
- 3. 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA (high school or college) to apply and maintain eligibility for this scholarship
- 4. Student must be pursuing full-time ministry, with preference given to students who plan to pursue work in full-time, overseas missions
- 5. Demonstrated financial need (as determined by the FAFSA)

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The donors would like to connect with students who receive the scholarship. By submitting an application for this scholarship, you are consenting to the review of your essay and if chosen, agree to write a thank you note and are open to meeting with the donors at the beginning of the academic year.

This scholarship will be divided between 2-4 Portland Campus students per academic year, and awarded up to \$10,000 per recipient. Applicants may reapply each year to be considered for this scholarship.
