SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

Multnomah is pleased to offer the Ione (Widing) Winqvist Memorial Scholarship to students enrolled in a full-time Undergraduate on campus program, or full-time Graduate/Seminary on-campus or online program, who are pursuing a degree in ministry and plan to serve in full-time missions overseas.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Submit a FAFSA for the 2021-22 award year (include Multnomah school code: 003206)
2. Submit a 1-2 page essay response (include your full name and student ID at the top of the page):
 - ***Please detail your vocational goals, call to ministry, and milestone accomplishments that set you apart from your peers.***
3. Submit your essay response to finaid@multnomah.edu.

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

Students who meet the following requirements are eligible to apply:

1. Must be one of the following full-time student types:
 - Undergraduate on-campus or
 - Graduate/Seminary on-campus or
 - Graduate/Seminary online
2. A completed FAFSA with Multnomah's school code (003206) (www.fafsa.gov)
3. 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA (high school or college) to apply and maintain eligibility for this scholarship
4. Student must be pursuing full-time ministry, with preference given to students who plan to pursue work in full-time, overseas missions
5. Demonstrated financial need (as determined by the FAFSA)

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The donors would like to connect with students who receive the scholarship. By submitting an application for this scholarship, you are consenting to the review of your essay and if chosen, agree to write a thank you note and are open to meeting with the donors at the beginning of the academic year.

This scholarship will be divided between 2-4 students per academic year, and awarded up to \$10,000 per recipient. Applicants may reapply each year to be considered for this scholarship.
