

Natural Sciences Department: Full Time Faculty in Exercise Science

Position Description:

Candidates will be expected to teach undergraduate courses in the face- to-face environment The candidate must be able to teach courses in the Exercise Science program, including Anatomy & Physiology, Exercise Physiology, Kinesiology, Nutrition, and related courses. Candidates will be expected to work closely with the Department Chair to build and grow the exercise science program, which is relatively new, and to build connections between the university and community. Student advising, chapel attendance, and participation in faculty/student collaboration opportunities, such as clubs and supervising internships, is also expected.

Minimum Requirements: A strong interest in undergraduate teaching is required. Candidates must have an earned a master's degree in an exercise science-related field (kinesiology, exercise physiology, athletic training, physical therapy, or other comparable fields) and must have experience teaching at an undergraduate level. Ph.D. or doctorate in an exerciserelated field (including DPT or DC) is strongly preferred. Relevant professional work experience is preferred. Support of the mission of Multnomah University and agreement with MU's doctrinal statement is required.

The successful candidate will:

- Provide excellent teaching to undergraduate students in a variety of delivery formats.
- Actively integrate the Christian faith in teaching.
- Have relevant work experience in exercise science to bring real-world experience into the classroom.
- Engage in service to the university and community.
- Actively build connections for students into the exercise science community

Institutional Information:
