

## Full Time Faculty, Bible/Theology; Assistant Professor of Theology

**Position Description:** A full-time faculty position teaching undergraduate and seminary students in the

School of Biblical & Theological Studies. Responsibilities include teaching theology, academic advising, and university service. The preferred candidate will have specialization in the area of historical theology, though the area of focus is open.

Minimum Requirements: This position requires a minimum of a Ph.D. (ABD will be considered), and a desire to

teach and mentor students. Teaching experience is preferred. Applicants are expected to have relevant professional experiences in the field and ongoing research interests.

Support of the University mission and doctrinal statement is required.

The preferred candidate will have experience teaching in a variety of modalities, a strong interest in faith integration, and an active research interest that could potentially

involve students.
