



Full Time Faculty, Assistant Professor of History

Position Description: Multnomah University invites applications for an Assistant Professor of history with a projected start date of July 1, 2023. This is a full-time faculty position with a course load of 24 credit semester hours per year. Responsibilities include undergraduate classroom instruction, academic advising of history majors, and university service. Preferred area of specialization in European history with the ability to teach Western Civilization survey, historical methods, the history of Christianity, and upper division European electives for history majors. Applicants with a developing scholarly interest in European cultural and religious history and the transatlantic world are especially encouraged to apply.

Minimum Requirements: The position requires a Master of Arts in history, with a Ph.D. or commitment to pursue a Ph.D. in history preferred. Teaching experience in higher education beneficial. Candidates are expected to have a familiarity with current educational technology and modalities. Successful candidate will have a strong interest in the integration of faith and learning. Support of the University mission and doctrinal statement is required.

Institutional Information: Multnomah University includes undergraduate and graduate programs as well as Multnomah Biblical Seminary located in Portland, OR. All programs are coeducational and interdenominational. Founded in 1936, the college, graduate school, and seminary have established a heritage of excellence in biblical education equipping Christian men and women to transform our culture and the world. The university offers B.A. and B.S. degrees in 19 majors as well as five university M.A. programs and one M.S. program. The seminary offers M.A., M.Div., and D.Min. degrees. Multnomah University is accredited with the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU). Multnomah Biblical Seminary is accredited with the Association of Theological Schools (ATS). In addition, Multnomah University is a member of the Council for Christian Colleges and Universities (CCCCU).
