BEFORE YOU REGISTER

- 1. If you are a **new** student your enrollment deposit and payment arrangements are due prior to registration.
- 2. **Current Students**: Your account must be current to register. Login to Self-Service to check the status of your account. If you have a "stop" that says Student Accounts or Payment, contact Student Accounts to take care of your account.
- 3. If any of the following items are outstanding you will not be cleared to register:
 Admissions related documents if provisionally admitted (see Office of the Registrar)
 Immunization information (see Office of the Registrar)
- 4. Plan your schedule using a catalog or course plan from the year you started. A copy of the class schedule is attached. Classes for spring semester can also be viewed on the Multnomah website (www.multnomah.edu) in Self-Service. If you need assistance in planning your schedule, contact your faculty advisor. New students may contact the Office of the Registrar for assistance prior to your first semester.

SCHEDULE FOR REGISTRATION

Online registration will start at the times listed below for each group.

Current Students

Second and Third year graduate students (Class S2 or S3) First year graduate students (Class S1) October 30, 8:00 a.m. November 1, 8:00 a.m.

New Students

New students will be able to register starting November 12, after they are admitted and have paid their enrollment deposit. Detailed instructions will be sent via e-mail in mid-November.

Returning Students

Former students who are returning after an absence need to contact Admissions to complete the re-enrollment process prior to being able to register. Returning students will be able to register between November 6 and January 5.

On-line registration will close for all students January 5 at 5:00 p.m. Late registration will open on January 8 for students who are not registered for classes. Late registration will take place at the Office of the Registrar between the hours of 9:00 and 4:00. Late registration cannot be done on-line.

HOW YOU REGISTER

Plan your schedule for next semester. Access Self-Service and register for your classes (Follow the directions on the attached page for online registration). The system will check to make sure that all prerequisites are met and that you do not have any schedule conflicts. During late registration contact the Office of the Registrar to register.

IMPORTANT ITEMS TO NOTE (related to on-line registration)

First year seminary students must limit their choice of electives to 500 and 600 level classes.

It is strongly recommended that you follow the course sequence as laid out in the course plan for your program. These can be found at MyMU under Registrar, Advising, Course Plans (use this link

https://multnomahuniversity.sharepoint.com/sites/MyMU/SitePages/Course-Plans.aspx). Complete all first-year courses before taking second year courses, etc. This will prevent you from having scheduling difficulties in later semesters. Contact the Office of the Registrar if you have questions about this.

If you get an error message on one or more of the classes that you have selected to take, remove that class from your selections and save your other classes. If you believe that you should be able to take the class, contact the Office of the Registrar. We will review your situation and add the class if you qualify to take it.

Note about course fees: Some courses have a course fee in addition to tuition. You can find the fee amount by clicking on the course ID in Self-Service.

AFTER YOU REGISTER

Classes begin on Monday, January 8.

You should verify your class schedule in Self-Service prior to the first day of class to make sure everything is correct. Report any errors to the Office of the Registrar by January 12.

Add/Drop

Students may add or drop courses at the Office of the Registrar or online Jan. 8-12. The final day to add a class to your spring schedule is Friday, Jan. 12 by 4:00 p.m. You may still withdraw from classes, after Jan. 12, but you must contact the Office of the Registrar. A \$5.00 fee will also be assessed for each registration change after Jan. 12. (Veterans and students receiving financial aid note limitations on Progress Standards.)

Late Registration

Late registration begins on Monday, January 8. January 12 by 4:00 p.m. will be the last date to register. Late registration must be completed in person at the Office of the Registrar.

Online Registration Instructions for Self-Service

1. Login to Self-Service.

New students - use the same user ID and password that you *just created* to access the Multnomah network.

Continuing students – contact IT (503.251.6555 or helpdesk@multnomah.edu) if you can't remember your password.

New students complete step 2, continuing students skip to step 3.

- 2. Select your profile icon in the upper right corner of the screen and then select the *Addresses* section. A campus box number has been assigned if you are living on campus. Review your permanent address and verify that it is correct. If not, make changes and submit change. If you are not living in the residence halls, student apartments or at your permanent address, please create a secondary address and supply your current local address. If there are addresses displayed that are no longer valid, please delete them.
- 3. Select Registration and then Courses.
- 4. Use Search to find your courses. You can enter your course code or course title in the Search bar (i.e., BIB502 or TH 508) or select Advanced Search and utilize the filters. Add the course that you want to your cart by clicking on the *ADD* button. Repeat this step for each course.
- 5. After you have selected your courses and they are in your cart, you need to register for them. Do this by clicking on *REGISTER*. If all goes well, you will be registered for your courses, and you can print out the page showing your schedule.
 - If you get a "Registration failed" message when you are registering your courses, you will need to correct the problem and then re-register your courses by clicking on *REGISTER*. The system checks for time conflicts, prerequisites and corequisites. If you believe you should be able to enroll in a course that the computer is not allowing, please <u>register for all your other courses</u> and then talk with one of the registrar's staff about the course that you could not register for.
- 6. Logout when you are done.
