### **1. 2022 Notice of Proposed Work (NPW) for Stream Maintenance Program**

The 2022 Notice of Proposed Work (NPW) for the Stream Maintenance Program (SMP) was successfully submitted for review/approval to regulatory agencies on April 15, 2022. This annual submittal drives the majority of Watersheds Operations & Maintenance's focus for the upcoming construction season. A total of 200+ projects were submitted and are summarized below.

In addition, a new data sharing platform called "SMP Cloud" was launched to aid in agency review and record keeping. The cloud database has geospatial and other functions that will assist with review of project information included in the NPW as well as provide access to previous year's work.

The submittal included:

- 19 Bank Repair projects on 12 streams
- 11 Sediment Removal projects on 10 streams
- 1 Animal Damage Management project on Guadalupe River
- 165 Vegetation Management projects ranging from herbicide application to tree removals
- 4 Invasive Plant Management Program projects on 3 streams to mitigate for temporary impacts
- 2 Revegetation projects on 2 streams to be mitigated for permanent impacts
- 1 Instream Complexity project on Uvas Creek to be mitigated for permanent instream impacts

## 2. Annual Report for Sustainable Groundwater Management Act Compliance

Per the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA), all basins assigned as medium or high priority by the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) must comply with SGMA. In December 2021, Valley Water submitted the 2021 Groundwater Management Plan for the Santa Clara and Llagas Subbasins to DWR as the first periodic update to the approved Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) Alternative. In January 2022, a GSP for the North San Benito Subbasin (which has small portions in Santa Clara County) was also submitted to DWR by the San Benito County Water District in coordination with Valley Water.

SGMA requires submittal of an annual report on groundwater conditions for the preceding water year by April 1. Valley Water has submitted the Water Year 2021 report for both the Santa Clara and Llagas Subbasins, which covers the time period from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021. The report is publicly available at: [sgma.water.ca.gov/portal/alternative/annualreport/submitted](https://sgma.water.ca.gov/portal/alternative/annualreport/submitted). The report documents continued sustainable groundwater despite drought conditions. The San Benito County Water District submitted the Water Year 2021 report for the North San Benito Subbasin, which is available at: [sgma.water.ca.gov/portal/gspar/submitted](https://sgma.water.ca.gov/portal/gspar/submitted). Valley Water will notify interested parties of the availability of these annual reports.

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## 3. Safe, Clean Water Grant Closeout: Breathe California of the Bay Area's Youth for a Cool Earth Project

In Fiscal Year 2018, Valley Water awarded Breathe California of the Bay Area a \$35,000 Safe, Clean Water Program B7 Grant for their Youth for a Cool Earth Project (Project). Breathe California of the Bay Area completed the Project on January 18, 2022 and submitted the final invoice items on October 29, 2021, allowing for grant closeout.

Breathe California of the Bay Area is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that provides a wide array of local services to address the most important lung health issues facing our communities today. The Youth for a Cool Earth Program (Y4CE) was designed to empower youth to become environmental leaders and advocates to their peers, school, family, and community, giving students an opportunity to join the fight against global warming in the Bay Area. The program took a multi-faceted approach to empower students with practical skills and knowledge that they can use to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The 10-week in-person program was offered to 50 youth at youth agencies, faith-based groups, community-based organizations (CBOs), schools, and other community partners in Santa Clara County, and used the Oxygen for You (O24u) curriculum that was developed to align with California Environmental Education Initiative principles. As a result, students received leadership and peer mentoring training on the nature of global warming, the causes and effects, and why it is something they should care about.

### Key Outcomes:

- Trained 273 youth and 37 peer leaders on environmental education
- Conducted a creek clean-up and collected 1,000 pounds of trash
- Developed computer game for Earth Day, which reached 4,600 people on social media
- Conducted post-event survey in which 78% of participants reported positive environmental behavior changes in reusing, reducing, and recycling to save resources and reduce water pollution

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#### **4. Valley Water Hosts groundbreaking ceremony for South San Francisco Bay Shoreline Project, Phase 1**

On April 14, 2022, Valley Water hosted a groundbreaking ceremony at the Alviso County Marina to celebrate the first phase of the South San Francisco Bay Shoreline Project construction, a multi-agency effort that includes the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the California State Coastal Conservancy.

The event drew approximately 80 attendees that included elected officials, participants from partner agencies, media and staff. The Valley Water Board of Directors were represented by Chair Pro Tem John L. Varela and Director Richard P. Santos, who provided remarks, along with Director Tony Estremera. CEO Rick Callender emceed the event, which was livestreamed on Facebook so members of the public could watch in real time.

Chair Pro Tem John Varela provided welcome remarks during the virtual event, which was also joined by Director Barbara Keegan.

Valley Water gave four brief presentations focused on the drought, recycled water infrastructure in South County, the rate-setting process and Anderson Dam. Additional Valley Water staff were available to answer questions about wells, groundwater and the Upper Llagas Creek Flood Protection Project. Prepared questions were answered after the presentations concluded. A total of four attendees joined the virtual event.

### SUMMARY:

In accordance with Santa Clara Valley Water District ("Valley Water") Investment Policy and California Government Code sections 53607 and 53646, the Treasurer's Monthly and Quarterly Report of Investments as of March 31, 2022 is attached. This report complies with Executive Limitation-4 Financial Management.

### RATIONALE:

California Government Code section 53607 requires the Treasurer of the local agency who has been delegated with the authority to invest funds to provide a monthly report of the investment transactions to the legislative body. Furthermore, Government Code Section 53646 recommends that the Treasurer submit a quarterly report to the legislative body of the local agency to assist with its fiscal oversight role. The quarterly report shall include the types of investment, issuer, date of maturity, par, market value and dollar amount for all securities, investments and moneys held by the local agency. The report shall also confirm compliance of the portfolio with the investment policy as well as a statement denoting the agency's ability to meet its expenditure requirements for the next six months. This report is provided to the Board in compliance with Board Investment Policy and Government Code sections 53607 and 53646.

### STAFF ANALYSIS:

#### Interest Rates

The yield-to-maturity of the investment portfolio as of March 31, 2022, was 1.03%. This represents a decrease of 0.04% compared to the yield of 1.07% for December 31, 2021.

Table 1 below summarizes the historical yield-to-maturity of the investment portfolio.

## Investment Strategy

In accordance with the strategy recommended by the Investment Committee and approved by the Board, staff continues to ladder the portfolio. When funds mature, if the money is not needed for current expenditures, they are reinvested in securities that have maturities of up to five years.

The average life of the portfolio on March 31, 2022 was 612 days (1.7 years), well within the 2.5-year average life threshold permitted by the Investment Policy. During the quarter, the Treasury Officer purchased 13 securities totaling \$65M and yield-to-maturity ranging from 1.27% to 2.60% and weighted average yield-to-maturity of 1.64%.

Valley Water's portfolio is invested with a primary goal of safety. To accomplish this goal, staff only invests in securities that are permitted by California Government Code and the Valley Water Investment Policy. These securities have high credit ratings and maturities of no more than 5 years. As of March 31, 2022, approximately 68% of the portfolio was held in US Government Treasury/Agency Notes and Municipal Bonds, 28% was held in liquid funds (Local Area Investment Fund/money market mutual fund, CD's) and 4% in supranational/corporate medium-term notes.

The low short-term interest rate environment is primarily driven by the continued low Federal Funds target rate. At the March 15-16, 2022 meeting, the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) stated: "With appropriate firming in the stance of monetary policy, the Committee expects inflation to return to its 2 percent objective and the labor market to remain strong. In support of these goals, the Committee decided to raise the target range for the federal funds rate to  $\frac{1}{4}$  to  $\frac{1}{2}$  percent and anticipates that ongoing increases in the target range will be appropriate."<sup>1</sup>

Staff recommends continuing the strategy of investing in short-term, liquid instruments such as money market mutual funds, Local Area Investment Fund (LAIF), high grade corporate medium-term notes and short-term U.S. government treasury and agency securities until financial markets show clear and continued signs of stabilization and improvement. While this strategy has the effect of achieving a lower investment yield compared to a longer-term investment strategy, safety and liquidity of the investment portfolio will be maintained. Staff will look for value within the five-year horizon and will match maturities with cash flow requirements as opportunities arise.

## Interest Income

For the quarter ended March 31, 2022, Valley Water received total interest earnings of \$5.17 million. Table 2 below illustrates the historical interest earnings of the investment portfolio.

## Performance Measurement

Valley Water benchmarks its portfolio performance against the 24-month floating average of the 2-year Treasury note. This benchmark approximates relatively closely to the holdings of Valley Water. However, there is no benchmark that will exactly mimic the Valley Water's mix of investments.

For the quarter ended March 31, 2022, the investment portfolio yield-to-maturity was 1.03% while the benchmark yield was 0.37% for a positive difference of 0.66%. Yields on the 2-year Treasury note reflect the gradually lowering interest rate in the short end of the yield curve. Valley Water's portfolio yields are modestly higher because of the staggered maturity investment strategy described above and holding to maturity certain securities purchased in times of higher rates.

As a result of low interest rates in the current market environment, the redemption of higher-yielding callable securities and the continued maturities of securities bought in better economic times, the yield on the investment portfolio is expected to remain modest over the next few quarters but may gradually increase over time as the U.S. economy improves and global uncertainties wane. The introduction of COVID19 vaccines and the deployment to the population has begun to ease some uncertainties. The portfolio will continue to be invested according to the tenets of safety, liquidity and yield in conformance with the California Government Code and Valley Water Investment Policy.

### Summary of Cumulative Changes in the Investment Portfolio

The book value of the portfolio was approximately \$692 million on March 31, 2022 compared to \$630 million on December 31, 2021, an increase of \$62 million or 9.8%. This increase reflects the normal fluctuations of the Valley Water's investment portfolio due to receipt of expected revenues (e.g. property taxes, water utility revenues, etc.) which are offset by planned expenditures for debt service, operating and capital projects incurred during the quarter. The historical quarterly changes in book value are summarized in Table 3 below.

### Portfolio Market Valuation

In accordance with California Government Code, all public agencies must report unrealized gains and losses in their investment portfolios on a quarterly basis. Table 4 below shows the market value of Valley Water's investments as reported by ICE Data Pricing & Reference Data, LLC on March 31, 2022 compared to the amortized book value.

If the entire portfolio had been liquidated on March 31, 2022, Valley Water would have received \$14.9 million less than the total amortized cost of the portfolio. This is the result of a direct relationship between changes in market interest rates and the value of investment securities. As general market interest rates increase, the value of investments purchased at lower yields decrease, and as general market interest rates decrease, the value of investments purchased at higher yields increase.

Valley Water's Investment Policy dictates a buy-and-hold strategy in which the Valley Water holds all securities to their maturity under normal operating conditions. When an investment matures, Valley Water is paid the full-face value of that security and therefore incurs no loss or gain. Since the portfolio was not liquidated, the "gain" was unrealized and had no impact on the portfolio size or yield.

## Collateralization of Outstanding Repurchase Agreements

As of March 31, 2022, Valley Water had no outstanding repurchase agreements.

## Debt Information

The Investment Policy and governmental regulations require that Valley Water report on the investment of bond proceeds. Investment of bond proceeds is governed by the legal bond documents and applicable governmental regulations. In particular, these funds can be invested for longer periods to match the terms of the outstanding bonds.

## Investment of Debt Proceeds

Table 5 below summarizes the debt proceeds investment information as of March 31, 2022. The investments of the debt proceeds are in accordance with the provisions for Permitted Investments as specified in each corresponding Indenture/Trust Agreement.

## Compliance with State Law and Valley Water Policy

For the quarter ended March 31, 2022, all investments were in compliance with the Investment Policy and Board Executive Limitation 7.6.

Valley Water holds several Certificates of Deposit (“CD”) issued by various banks and credit unions. The CD account balances are generally maintained at or below the federal insurance maximum of \$250,000 per CD, with the exception of the following CDs which are separately insured by Letters of Credit from the Federal Home Loan Bank of San Francisco with a minimum of 105% insurance value for account balances in excess of the \$250,000 federal insurance limit: Community Bank of the Bay, Bank of San Francisco and Technology Credit Union.

On October 13, 2020, the Board authorized placing a deposit of up to \$14 million in a Certificate of Deposit Account Registry Service (CDARS) account with the Bank of San Francisco as part of the transaction related to the establishment of a \$170 million syndicated bank line of credit. The Bank of San Francisco CDAR account in the amount of \$14 million was established on October 29, 2020, and all account balances held in the CDAR is insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

The investment portfolio has been structured to ensure that sufficient monies will be available to cover anticipated expenditures in the coming six months.

## Socially Responsible Investments

In a unanimous vote on December 12, 2017, the board voted to amend the investment policy to promote socially responsible investment (SRI) practices, and adopted a set of moral, ethical, environmental, social and governance guiding principles (ESG) to lead investment decisions. The board approved prioritizing local investment possibilities with California based banks and banks with less than \$10 billion in assets, to keep funds in the local economy and promote local job growth. On August 11, 2020, the board enhanced the ESG policy to keep a minimum of 4% of liquid cash in banks with up to \$10 billion in assets and 1% in banks with up to \$2 billion in assets to promote Valley Water's investments in local community banks

Total CDs and deposits placed with local banks and credit union is \$41 million for the period ended March 31, 2022. This represents approximately 6% of the overall Valley Water portfolio's book value. The change in Valley Water's investment in CDs and collateralized deposits is summarized in Table 6 below.

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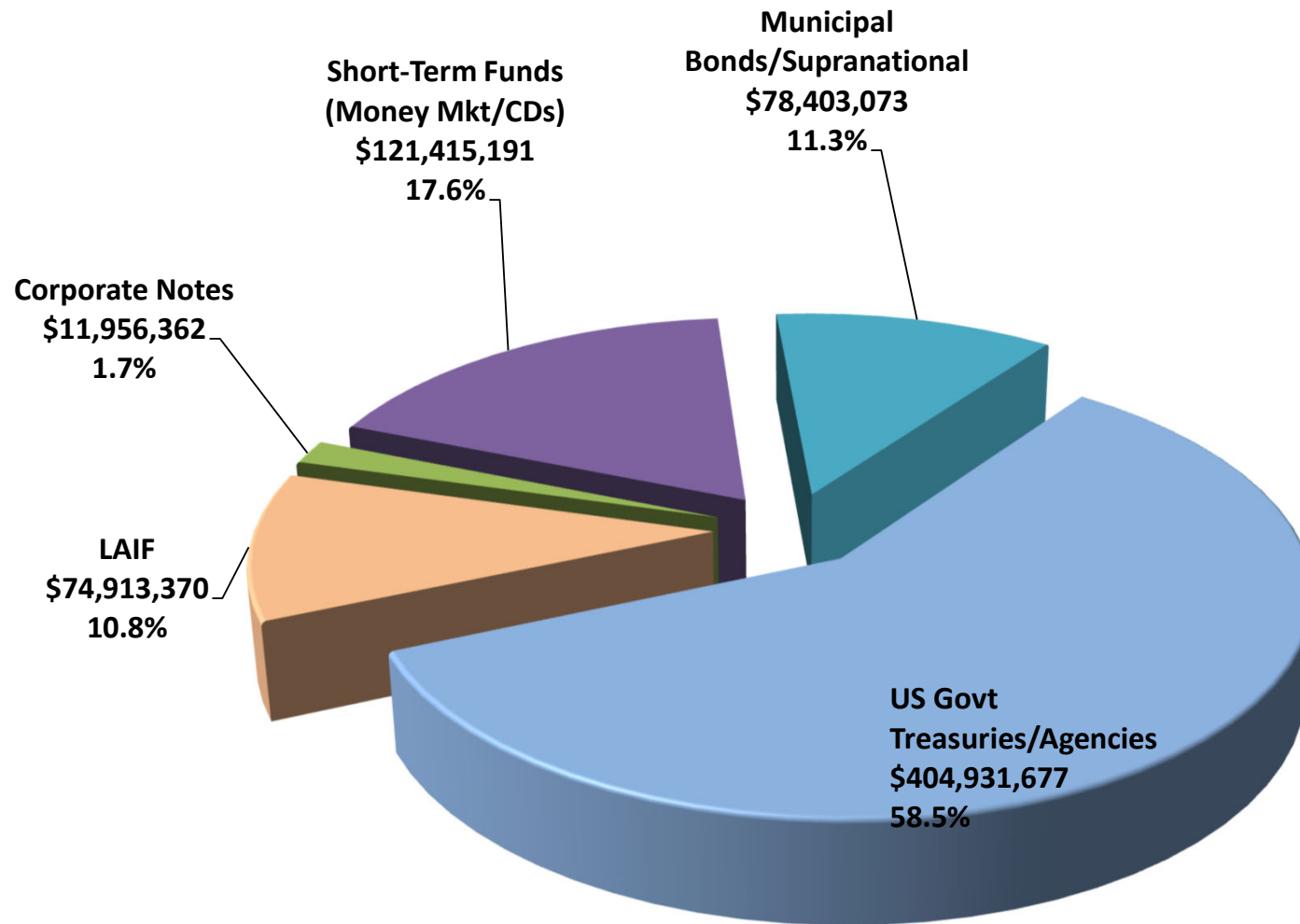
