
VitalView allows you to link two files, from any source, on a like field or group of like fields, to enable visualization of the relationship between files.




Link your CDM line items to your Pharmacy Formulary or Pharmacy system file.






Link CPT and HCPCS codes in your CDM to your Payer fee schedules for improved visibility.






Link your CDM line items to your Supply Files to see the actual supplies detail.






Link your CDM line items to your Preference Lists to see all lists that need to be updated with code changes.






Load detailed alternate Revenue or CPT/HCPCS code files to increase visibility into alternate code application logic.



Link your CDM line items to your Linked Chargeables to increase visibility.






- Add Purchase History data to link to your pharmacy or supply file and compare to usage to ensure you aren't stacking up on crazy amounts of product you don't utilize.



Using the Lookup – Adding an Approved Manufacturer Name


 Users can search the list; click on an item and hit Apply to fill in the designated field





Using the Crosswalk to Auto Populate – Nobody should have to remember that Revenue Code 0420 always belongs to Billing Category Physical Therapy.



Do you ever wonder when that CDM line item changed?


All of your changes are shown in pink with the most recent being on top. Even request information is captured; scroll to the far right to see the details.





Reviewing Professional Fee Schedule payments?



Does your CDM file have multiple CPT/HCPCS codes columns?







