Types of TA Provided by the VRTAC

Universal

- Accessible to everyone at any time needed, including VRTAC website, resources, and on-demand trainings.

Targeted

- Includes specific needs and requests, limited period of time, and can be accessed at any time and as often as needed.

Intensive

- Includes activities and outputs, an extended period of time, outcome measures, and a signed agreement.


