

Green Hills County Park Big Group Trip Guidelines

Tips for making your trip to Green Hills County Park a success!

Please call (919) 870-4330 to let us know when your group of 50 or more is planning to visit.

This is NOT a reservation, but will allow us to better serve you.

Park Hours:

- The Park is open every day except New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.
- The Park opens at 8:00 am and the gates are locked at dusk the exact time is on the sign upon entering the Park, in addition to being posted along the one way loop road.

Picnicking:

- No open flames are allowed at this facility (this includes use of grills).
- The Sycamore Shelter and all picnic tables throughout the park are first-come, first-served. Please be considerate when claiming these amenities staking out the shelter or other tables at 9:00 am for a 1:00 pm picnic prevents others from using the space before that time.
- Food trucks and on-site catering are prohibited (this includes ice cream trucks). Caterers must set up food and leave.

Activities:

- EZ-Up style tents are allowed as are portable badminton and volleyball nets.
- If you are considering carnival-type activities, please call us for information on our requirements and restrictions. NO inflatable structures/bounce houses/gaming trucks are allowed.
- You will have no access to electrical or water hook-ups.
- No water balloons are permitted due to hazard potential for wildlife. Consider bringing wet sponges in a cooler of water instead.
- No amplified music or alcohol is allowed in the park.
- Drones and Model Rockets are **prohibited** at this park. Please refer to the GHCP Model Rocket, Drone and Remote Control Vehicle Policy on the website for more information.
- Remind your group to remain on the designated paths around and on the landfill at all times. To prevent injury, do not walk or ride bikes on the slopes of the landfill. You may access the top of the landfill from the "Top of the Hill Trail" gravel trail located near the park entrance sign park at the Front Entrance parking lot and walk the concrete road to the right to access the Top of the Hill Trail.
 *Remain on the designated gravel trail at all times. Use of landfill hill slopes for any activity is prohibited.

Clean-Up:

- Pick up all litter and recyclables associated with your group's visit and dispose of them properly.
- Trash and recycling containers are located throughout the park.
