GRAND TOTALS from 2003-2019:

- 389,546.0 lbs / 194.8 tons of unhealthy and unsightly litter removed
- 19,097 Big Sweep volunteers donated 48,129 hours valued at \$1,225,482 (at annual hourly rate determined nationally by Independent Sector)
- Over 65 Big Sweep Zone Captains led cleanups
- Over 60+ watershed sites across Wake County were cleaned (once or repeatedly)
- 12 participating Wake County municipalities throughout the years:

 Apex, Cary, Fuquay-Varina, Garner, Holly Springs, Knightdale, Morrisville, New Hill, Raleigh, Wake Forest, Wendell and Zebulon and sites in north and south Wake County
