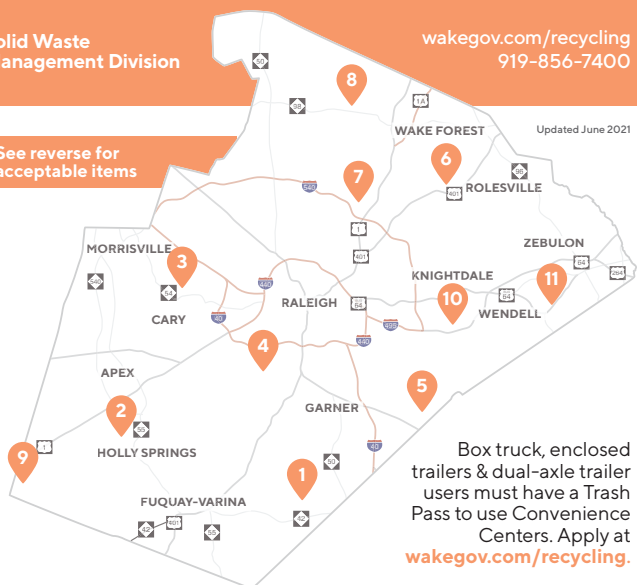

<b>Appliances</b> (a/c, heater units, fridge, washer, dryer)			
<b>Automotive</b> (anti-freeze, motor oil, oil filters)			
<b>Batteries</b> (rechargeable: electronics, tools, phones. non-rechargeable: alkaline, lithium, 9-volt, button cell, watch. lead acid: vehicle, boat, motorcycle) Tape terminals of lithium & lithium-ion batteries.			
<b>Cardboard</b> (clean, flattened, all packing material removed)			
<b>Chemicals</b> (acids, bases, fertilizers, herbicides, pesticides, poisons)			
<b>Clothing, shoes &amp; books</b>			
<b>Cooking oil</b>			
<b>Construction debris</b> (lumber, drywall, carpet, tiles) HOMEOWNER WASTE ONLY. No concrete or pavers. <i>Sites 1, 2, 4, 7, 10 &amp; 11 only</i>	 1, 2, 4, 7, 10, 11		
<b>Discs &amp; tapes</b> (cd, bluray, dvd, vhs)			
<b>Electronics</b> (any corded electronic device, cell phones) <i>Sites 1, 4 &amp; East Wake on weekends only</i>	 1, 4		
<b>Finishes</b> (lacquers, oil-based paints, spray paint, solvents, stains, thinners)			
<b>Fire extinguishers</b> (dry chemical)			
<b>Flammables</b> (gas, fuel oil, kerosene, propane tanks)			
<b>Fluorescent light bulbs</b> (CFLs, bring bulbs in a box)			
<b>Food waste</b> (cooked meats, dairy, fruits, vegetables, eggs, baked goods, coffee grounds, pizza boxes, paper napkins, paper towels) Remove all food from packaging. <i>Locations at <a href="https://wakegov.com/foodwaste">wakegov.com/foodwaste</a>.</i>			
<b>Garbage</b> (household waste, furniture, mattresses, bulky items under 8 feet long/wide)			
<b>Mercury thermometers</b>			
<b>Mixed recycling</b> (metal food & drink cans; cartons; glass bottles & jars; mixed paper & cartons; plastic bottles, tubs, jugs & jars) <b>DON'T BAG RECYCLING.</b> No shredded paper. No plastic bags. No Styrofoam.			
<b>Oyster shells</b>			
<b>Paint latex</b> (10 can limit, consolidate paint) No rusted or dried-out paint cans.			
<b>Propane tanks</b>			
<b>Rigid plastic</b> (buckets, crates, storage tubs, plastic furniture) <i>North and South Wake sites only</i>			
<b>Scrap metal</b> (bikes, fixtures, frames, ladders, mixed metals, pipes, rims, sinks, grills, lawn mowers) Power equipment must be drained of gas & oil.			
<b>Tires</b> (rims removed, 5+ tires require NC Scrap Tire Form available at <a href="https://wakegov.com/recycling">wakegov.com/recycling</a> )
