

Appliances (a/c, heater units, fridge, washer, dryer) Automotive (anti-freeze, motor oil, oil filters) Batteries (rechargeable: electronics, tools, phones. non-rechargeable: alkaline, lithium, 9-volt, button cell, watch. lead acid: vehicle, boat, motorcycle) Tape terminals of lithium & lithium-ion batteries. O O (clean, flattened, all packing material removed) Chemicals (acids, bases, fertilizers, herbicides, pesticides, poisons) Clothing, shoes & books Cooking oil Construction debris (lumber, drywall, carpet, tiles) HOMEOWNER WASTE ONLY. 1, 2, 4, 7 10 11 No concrete or pavers. Sites 1, 2, 4, 7, 10 & 11 only O Discs & tapes (cd, bluray, dvd, vhs) Electronics (any corded electronic device, cell 1 4 phones) Sites 1, 4 & East Wake on weekends only Finishes (lacquers, oil-based paints, spray paint, solvents, stains, thinners) Fire extinguishers (dry chemical) Flammables (gas, fuel oil, kerosene, propane tanks) Fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs, bring bulbs in a box) Food waste (cooked meats, dairy, fruits, vegetables, eggs, baked goods, coffee grounds, pizza boxes, 3 paper napkins, paper towels) Remove all food from packaging. Locations at wakegov.com/foodwaste. Garbage (household waste, furniture, mattresses, bulky items under 8 feet long/wide) Mercury thermometers Mixed recycling (metal food & drink cans; cartons; glass bottles & jars; mixed paper & cartons; plastic bottles, tubs, jugs & jars) DON'T BAG RECYCLING. No shredded paper. No plastic bags. No Styrofoam. Oyster shells Paint latex (10 can limit, consolidate paint) O No rusted or dried-out paint cans. Propane tanks **Rigid plastic** (buckets, crates, storage tubs, plastic furniture) *North and South Wake sites only* Scrap metal (bikes, fixtures, frames, ladders, mixed

Box truck, enclosed trailers & dual-axle trailer users must have a Trash Pass to use Convenience Centers. Apply at wakegov.com/recycling.

metals, pipes, rims, sinks, grills, lawn mowers)
Power equipment must be drained of gas & oil.
