



HOW TO FIND YOUR PLANNING JURISDICTION

Follow the instructions below to determine if your property is in Wake County's jurisdiction.

OPTION 1

Search by Address, PIN, Owner or Real Estate ID

1. Open **iMAPS**
2. Search for the property on iMAPS in the upper right hand corner (by Address, PIN, Owner or Real Estate ID).



Tip: Use a partial address if the full address is not returning any results.

3. When your property has been found, scroll down under the General information and check to see if "Wake County" is listed as the Jurisdiction.




Note: If it says "Wake County," you are looking in the correct place for regulations. If it is another jurisdiction, you will need to contact your municipal planning department for more information.


OPTION 2

Search by Manually Locating Your Property on the Map

1. Open **iMAPS**
2. Find your property on the map and double-click.



3. Check to see if "WC" (Wake County) is listed as the Planning Jurisdiction on the pop-up box under General.



Note: If it says "WC" you are looking in the correct place for regulations. If it is another jurisdiction, you will need to contact your municipal planning department for more information.
