Through the experience of fly fishing in Montana, Warriors and Quiet Waters is a catalyst for positive change in the lives of post-9/11 combat veterans and their loved ones.

A Letter from Interim Executive Director and Board Chair

Warriors and Quiet Waters Foundation (WQW) closed our 13th season with another significant increase in the number of Warriors, Spouses, and Military Caregivers served. Since our inception in 2007, WQW has served 679 unique Warriors, Spouses, Caregivers, and Gold Star teenagers through 123 weeks of programs. We have doubled the number of annual programs since 2015. These increases are possible due to your steadfast and generous support.

Some notable 2019 accomplishments include:

DOUBLING THE NUMBER OF PROGRAMS FOR FEMALE COMBAT VETERANS. Women have served with distinction in every U.S. military conflict since the Revolutionary War. They are the fastest-growing demographic within the military, yet remain underserved. To help address this gap in services, WQW hosted two Fishing Experiences (FXs) specifically for 11 women Warriors.

DOUBLING THE NUMBER OF PROGRAMS FOR MILITARY CAREGIVERS. While there are thousands of resources for veterans across America, WQW has found that programs specifically for Military Caregivers of post-9/11 combat veterans are few and far between. These men and women often serve in the shadows. The Caregiver FX was inspired to cast light on their lives. WQW hosted two FXs for 13 caregivers, including three alumni who returned in leadership roles.

AN EXPANDED MISSION. To serve the loved ones of combat veterans, WQW and the Travis Manion Foundation have partnered to provide a program specifically for Gold Star teenagers. In addition to fly fishing in Montana, these Gold Star teens (children who lost an immediate family member in military service) participated in a conservation project in Yellowstone National Park.

COMPLETION OF THE QUIET WATERS RANCH CARETAKER HOME. Through a generous donation by the Yellowstone Club, WQW was able to complete the Caretaker Home, named in honor of Montana native, Medal of Honor recipient, Staff Sgt. Travis Atkins, U.S. Army.

A NEW STRATEGIC PLAN. By defining a more comprehensive scope of alumni support and emphasis on deepening relationships, the new strategic plan provides a roadmap for the next three years.

LAUNCHING A NEW ANNUAL FUNDRAISER. WQW's National Advisory Board spearheaded the inaugural Warrior Taste Fest fundraiser. With more than 500 people in attendance, a record number of people were able to connect to WQW's mission in a single evening.

Without the support of generous donors, gracious corporate sponsors, and hundreds of volunteers, WQW could not fulfill its mission. We continually evaluate programs, processes, and procedures to ensure we are maximizing your investment.

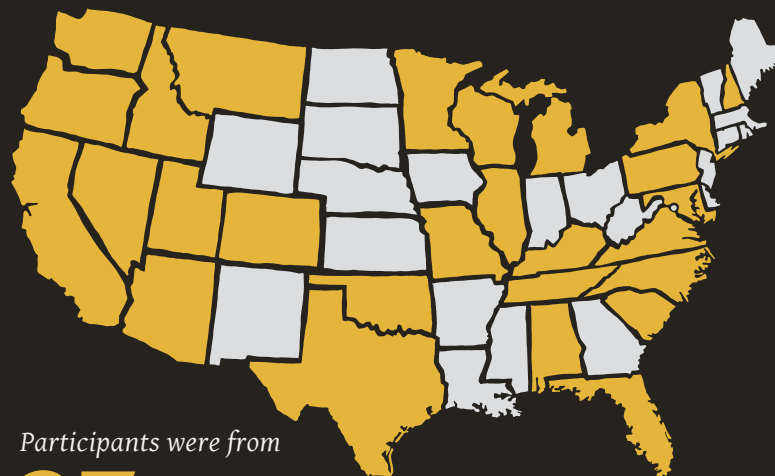

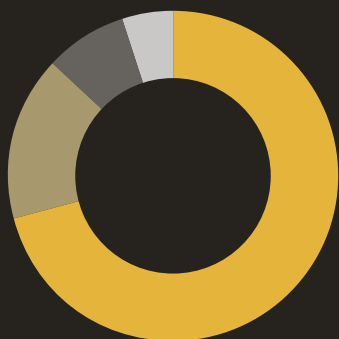

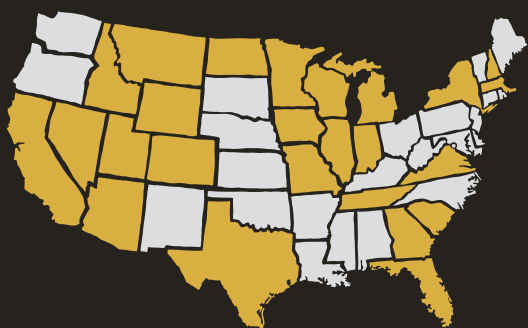

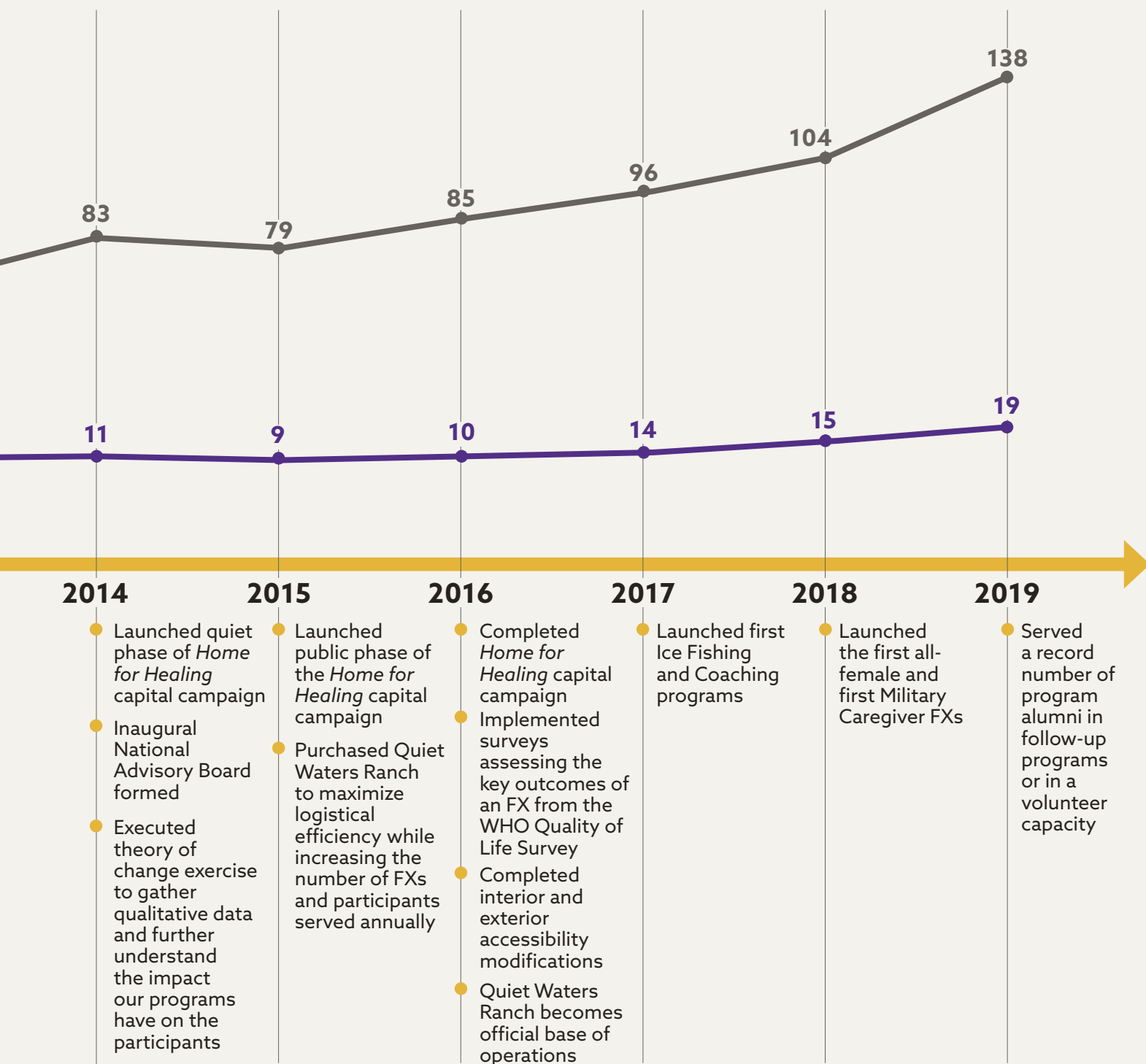

Finances

Thanks to over 1,550 individuals, businesses, and foundations who supported Warriors and Quiet Waters (WQW) in 2019, the foundation's financial health remains strong. This enables WQW to provide Gold Standard programs, rooted in the therapeutic benefits of fly fishing.

Compared to previous wars, veterans returning from Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom are more likely to have combat-related conditions of post-traumatic stress, traumatic brain injury, visual impairments, and/or amputations. Only recently have practitioners begun to document the positive outcomes of participation in outdoor recreation programs — something WQW's founder, U.S. Marine Colonel (Retired) Eric Hastings, has known since returning from the Vietnam War. To provide a more complete scope of support for post-9/11 combat veterans and their loved ones, WQW invests in core mission support including:

PRUDENT FISCAL MANAGEMENT: Strong strategic finances and accounting that enable Gold Standard programs. An annual certified independent audit.

INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY: A database conversion to amplify program effectiveness, facilitate collaboration, and streamline participant recruitment and placement. This implementation was a one-time, long-term investment with the Warriors' best interest in mind.

KEEPING PEOPLE AT THE HEART OF PROGRAMS: To ensure the best participant experience possible, WQW maintains high standards of professionalism through progressive human resource practices and talented and engaged staff.

The graphs on the right display the sources of income and associated expenses for 2019.

The explanation for the difference between total revenue and total expenses is:

- We received approximately \$57,000 in planned gifts, all of which are held until released to the program-focused Henry H. and Marion S. Uihlein Warrior Endowment Fund.
- We received a \$300,000 donation to complete construction of the Staff Sgt. Travis Atkins, U.S. Army, Caretaker Home.
- Over half of the \$2.7 million donated by individuals were permanently restricted endowment contributions.

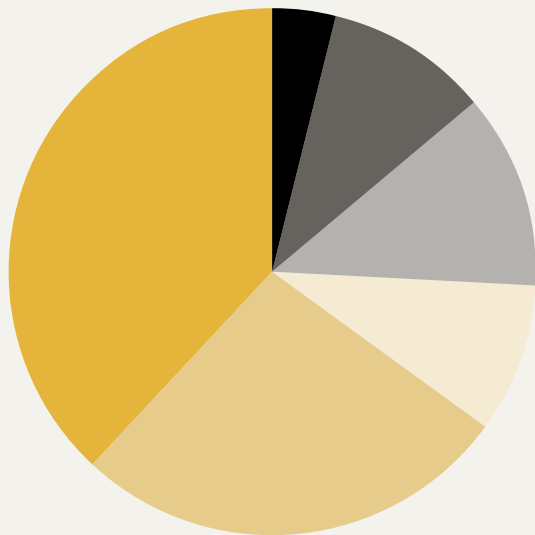
WQW is proud to announce that the investment return on the maintenance and management endowment account covered 100% of Quiet Waters Ranch expenses in 2019. In-kind donations made up 10% of revenue. 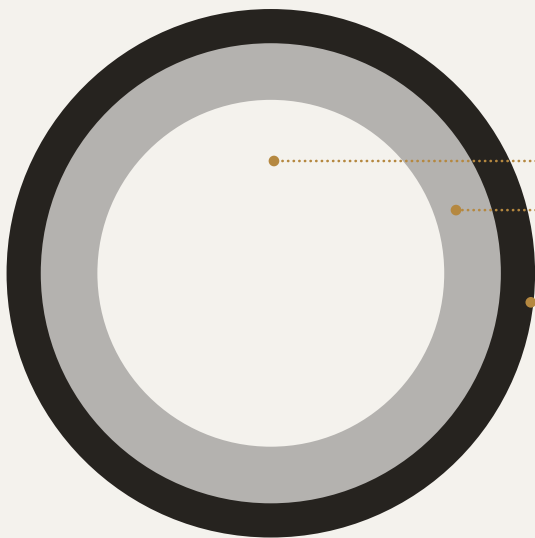
