

- Does not include Cascade Water Alliance


Pilot project overview

- What: a rebate to install in-line toilet leak detection devices
- Where: two remodeled multifamily buildings built in 1958 (103 units total)
- When: installed February 2024
- Why: Assess water-saving potential of the technology and the feasibility of scaling up as a full program offering




Single family home 60-day billing cycle


Multifamily building (70 units) 30-day billing cycle

- Still very early, but excited about the potential
- Learning curve for navigating and interpreting the dashboard
- Building management has been very engaged
- Work order format of dashboard, with customizable thresholds, has worked well with building maintenance
