

KING & QUEEN

The race to be named King or Queen of Crankworx is one of the most difficult competitions in mountain biking. This season-long, multidisciplinary challenge tabulates results from multiple event disciplines in a five-stop, epic test of a rider's skill and will. Racing from the Southern Hemisphere to the Canadian Coast mountains, athletes aim to collect as many points as possible for a shot at winning the \$30,000 prize. The most points wins.

TITLES / PRIZE MONEY

The top ranked athletes competing in the King & Queen of Crankworx standings are recognized through the following title and awards.

King and Queen: the two top ranked riders (male and female): \$9,000 CAD each

2nd place overall riders (male and female): \$4,000 CAD each

3rd place overall riders (male and female): \$2,000 CAD each

Titles/Awards will be presented at Crankworx Mont-Sainte-Anne.

ELIGIBILITY

A rider must compete and collect points in at least 2 disciplines of eligible events (outlined below) in order to be eligible to win a title/award.

Only riders competing in the Elite Men or Elite Women categories will be eligible.

EVENTS

Titles/awards will be based on results in the following individual events at Crankworx Christchurch, Rotorua, Whistler, SilverStar, and Mont-Sainte-Anne.

TIE BREAK

In the event of a tie for total points at the end of all relevant Crankworx World Tour competitions, the following rules will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- (a) The most first place finishes, or if still tied, the most second place finishes, or if still tied, the most 3rd place finishes, or if still tied,
- (b) Head-to-Head results in all common races/competitions if applicable.
- (c) In the event the tie cannot be broken using the above rules, the title and prize money will be divided.
