

KING and QUEEN

The race to be named King or Queen of the Crankworx World Tour is the most difficult competition in mountain biking. This season-long, multidisciplinary challenge tabulates results from multiple event disciplines in a four-stop, epic test of a rider's skill and will. Racing from the Alps to the Southern Hemisphere, athletes aim to collect as many points as possible for a shot at winning the \$20,000 prize. The most points wins.

TITLES / PRIZE MONEY

The top ranked athletes competing at the Crankworx World Tour are recognized through the following title and awards.

King and Queen: the two top ranked riders (male and female): \$20,000 CAD each

2nd place overall riders (male and female): \$10,000 CAD each

3rd place overall riders (male and female): \$5,000 CAD each

Titles/Awards will be presented on July 29, 2023 at Crankworx Whistler.

A minimum of two Crankworx Festivals in 2023 need to occur in order for the King and Queen title to be awarded

ELIGIBILITY

A rider must compete and collect points in at least 2 disciplines in order to be eligible to win a title/award. Only riders competing in the Pro Men or Pro Women categories will be eligible.

TIE BREAK

In the event of a tie for total points at the end of all relevant Crankworx World Tour competitions, the following rules will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- (a) The most first place finishes, or if still tied, the most second place finishes, or if still tied, the most 3rd place finishes, or if still tied,
- (b) Head-to-Head results in all common races/competitions if applicable.
- (c) In the event the tie cannot be broken using the above rules, the title and prize money will be divided.
