

# CRANKWORX WORLD TOUR DOWNHILL CHAMPIONSHIP

The race to be named the Crankworx Downhill Champion is back. The four-stop Downhill series will be an epic test, bringing athletes from the tropics to the Alps. Athletes aim to collect as many points as possible for a shot at winning the \$5,000 prize.

## **TITLES / PRIZE MONEY**

The male and female athletes with the highest points total over the course of the Crankworx season will be awarded the title of Crankworx Downhill Champion. They will receive \$5,000 CAD each.

This title will be presented on July 29, 2023 at Crankworx Whistler.

\*A minimum of two Crankworx Festivals in 2023 need to occur in order for the series title to be awarded\*

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Only riders competing in the Elite Men or Elite Women categories will be eligible.

## **EVENTS**

The Crankworx World Tour Downhill Standings will track the individual points for athletes who place in the top 30 at the UCI sanctioned Downhill races, taking place at Crankworx Rotorua, Crankworx Cairns, Crankworx Innsbruck and Crankworx Whistler.

#### **TIE BREAK**

In the event of a tie for total points at the end of all relevant Crankworx World Tour competitions, the following rules will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- (a) The most first place finishes, or if still tied, the most second place finishes, or if still tied, the most 3rd place finishes, or if still tied,
- (b) The highest placed rider at the Rockshox Canadian Open DH,
- (c) In the event the tie cannot be broken using the above rules, the title and prize money will be divided.



# **THE 1199 AWARD**

Named in honour of Stevie Smith's legendary points total, The 1199 Award (also referred to as "the 1199") will be awarded to a rider whose outstanding performance over the course of the Crankworx Downhill season pushes them to achieve a points total in excess of 1199 in the 1199 Award Standings.

## **TITLES / PRIZE MONEY**

The male and/or female athlete who collects more than 1199 points in the 1199 Award Standings will be awarded the 1199 Award. They will individually receive \$10,000 CAD.

If the feat is not achieved in a year, the prize money carries over, and the pot grows.

If an athlete collects more than 1199 points over the course of the season the 1199 Award will be presented on July 23, 2023 at Crankworx Whistler.

\*A minimum of two Crankworx Festivals in 2023 need to occur in order for the 1199 Award to be awarded\*

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Only riders competing in the Elite Men or Elite Women categories will be eligible.

# **EVENTS**

Points towards the 1199 Award Standings will be awarded to athletes who place in the top 30 at the UCI sanctioned Downhill races, taking place at Crankworx Rotorua, Crankworx Cairns, Crankworx Innsbruck and Crankworx Whistler.
