

WORLD TOUR RANKING & STANDINGS



Crankworx FMBA Slopestyle World Championship Standings

- All SWC event results of the current season
- Basis for the SWC PQ athletes
- Seeding for SWC events
- Determines the Slopestyle World Champion
- FMB World Tour License only

FMB World Tour Ranking

- Best 3 results within a 52week period
- Rolling Ranking
- Basis for event entry and seeding at FMB events
- FMB World Tour License only



Red Bull Rookie Standing

- Best 3 results from Gold, Silver and/or Bronze events in the current season
- Determines the Red Bull Rookie of the Year
- FMB World Tour or Amateur License

National Standings

- Available for specific countries approved to sanction a National Championship
- Filtered by select country from the FMB World Tour Ranking
- Basis for Invitations & Seeding for approved National Championships
- FMB World Tour License only

Gold Cup Standings

- Best 3 or 4 results (based on the number of Gold events on the calendar) in the current season
- Basis for the GC PQ athletes
- Bases for the Golden Tickets
- FMB World Tour License only

FMB WORLD TOUR EVENT ENTRY FOR ATHLETES



- Non-SWC Diamond Events shall invite the top 14 male athletes and top 6 female athletes based on rank in the FMB World Tour Ranking 6 weeks prior to the event
- SWC Diamond Events shall invite:
 - Men
 - 5 PQ'd SWC athletes
 - 1 PQ'd GC athlete
 - 1 Golden Ticket
 - 7 athletes from WT Ranking 6 weeks prior
 - Women
 - 2 PQ'd SWC athletes
 - 1 PQ'd GC athlete*
 - 3 athletes from WT Ranking 6 weeks prior
- Previous Red Bull Joyride winners are qualified for all future SWC events
- Option to have maximum 2 wildcards



- Each Gold Event shall invite:
 - Open Men
 - Top 25 athletes based on rank in the FMB World Tour Ranking 6 weeks prior to the event
 - Maximum 10 Wildcards (licensed or non-licenses athletes)
 - Open Women
 - Top 10 athletes based on rank in the FMB World Tour Ranking 6 weeks prior to the event
 - Maximum 5 Wildcards (licensed or non-licenses athletes)



- Each Silver Event shall invite:
 - Open Men
 - 10 x Reserved Entries for athletes ranked 11th - 30th based on rank in the FMB World Tour Ranking 6 weeks prior to the event
 - Remaining Entries can be allocated using open registration (WT license required)
 - Maximum 5 Wildcards
 - Open Women
 - 5 x Reserved Entries for the top 15 athletes based on rank in the FMB World Tour Ranking 6 weeks prior to the event
 - Remaining Entries can be allocated using open registration (WT license required)
 - Maximum 3 Wildcards



- Each Bronze event will have open registration
- No wildcards are allowed for nonlicensed athletes
- World Tour License athletes have priority access to competition in regards to rank in the FMB World Tour Ranking 6 weeks prior to the event
- Every athlete needs to hold either a World Tour License or an Amateur License to enter and compete

ATHLETE LICENSES

FMB World Tour License

- Cost: 100 EUR
- Membership Period: Annual (January to December)
- Categories: Open Men & Open Women
- Listed in the FMB World Tour Ranking, Crankworx FMBA Slopestyle World Championship Standings, Gold Cup Standings, Red Bull Rookie Standings and National Standings
- Required for entry into Diamond, Gold, Silver and Bronze events

FMB World Amateur License

- Cost: Free, registration required
- Membership Period: Annual (January to December)
- Categories: Open Men & Open Women
- Listed in the Red Bull Rookie Standings
- Access to Bronze events only
