

## 9. Deliverance Prayers




Deliverance Prayers are when via our praying (our words), someone is delivered of a demon, sickness, disease, attack, etc.

[7] So if you worship me, it will all be yours.” [8] Jesus answered, “It is written: ‘Worship the Lord your God and serve him only.’”







## Luke 4:10 (NIV)

[12] Jesus answered, “It says: ‘Do not put the Lord your God to the test.’”




## Luke 4:33–36 (NIV)


## Luke 4:33-36 (NIV)




## 10. Prayers of Petition

Petitions are definite, specific requests based on a Rhema word (promise) you're standing on.




Philippians 4:6



2: prayer, petition, or entreaty in favor of another



[27] Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.





[34] Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.




## Numbers 14:11-24 (NKJV)




## Numbers 14:11-24 (NKJV)


## Numbers 14:11-24 (NKJV)


## Numbers 14:11-24 (NKJV)








## John 16:13-15 (NKJV)





[3] For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. [4] They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths. [5] But you, keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.


2 Timothy 4:2

[2] Herald and preach the Word! Keep your sense of urgency [stand by, be at hand and ready], whether the opportunity seems to be favorable or unfavorable. [Whether it is convenient or inconvenient, whether it is welcome or unwelcome, you as preacher of the Word are to show people in what way their lives are wrong.] And convince them, rebuking and correcting, warning and urging and encouraging them, being unflagging and inexhaustible in patience and teaching.

Ephesians 4:11-16 (NIV)

[11] It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, [12] to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up [13] until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.



## Ephesians 4:11-16 (NIV)

[14] Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming. [15] Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ. [16] From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.
