## #13 - Warfare Prayers

Warfare Prayers are when we are praying to take down an enemy that is regional, generational, or a physical location.

- May be demonic, sickness, disease, circumstances, issues, situations, etc.



> Deliverance: Deals more with a person

> Warfare: Deals more with a spirit in an area, Issue affecting people, Physical Location.

- spirit of poverty / suicide working an area
- Generational / Ancestral / Indian curses
- (Buildings) - Houses, Churches, etc.

Ephesian  
s 6:10-13  
(NKJV)

---

[10] Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. [11] Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. [12] For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. [13] Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

# Ephesians 6:17-18 (NKJV)

---

[17] And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;  
[18] praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—



#14 - Praise & Worship Prayers

This is simply Praising and Worshipping Him as you pray.

Luke 10:21  
(NKJV)

[21] In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and prudent and revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight.

Ephesians  
3:14-16 (NKJV)

[14] For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, [15] from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, [16] that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man,.....

## Ephesians 3:20-21 (NKJV)

[20] Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, [21] to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

## Philippians 1:9-11 (NKJV)

[9] And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, [10] that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ, [11] being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.



## #15 - Prayer's of Thanksgiving

- This is expressing our Thanks to God.
- Before, During, and After we receive the Answer

Matthew 15:36  
(NKJV)

[36] And He took the seven loaves and the fish and gave thanks, (Before & During) broke them and gave them to His disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitude.

Matthew 26:27  
(NKJV)

[27] Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, (Before & During) and gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you.

Luke 17:15-  
19 (NKJV)

[15] And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, [16] and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. (After) And he was a Samaritan. [17] So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? [18] "Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" [19] And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."

Philippians  
4:6 (NKJV)

[6] Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, (Before) let your requests be made known to God;

Colossians  
2:6-7 (NKJV)

[6] As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, [7] rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving. (During)

1 Timothy  
2:1 (NKJV)

[1] Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks (Before, During, & After) be made for all men,

# Hebrews 13:15 (NKJV)

---

[15] Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name. (Before, During, & After)

## #16 - Praying in Tongues

Praying in Tongues is using the Tongue you were given at Your Baptism with the Spirit - to Pray.

Acts 2:4 (NIV)

[4] All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

# Mark 16:17 (NIV)

[17] And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues;

Acts 10:44-  
46 (NIV)

[44] While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message.

[45] The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles. [46] For they heard them speaking in tongues and praising God.

1 Corinthians 14:15  
(NIV)

[15] So what shall I do? I will pray with my spirit, but I will also pray with my mind; I will sing with my spirit, but I will also sing with my mind.

1 Corinthians  
14:18 (NIV)

[18] I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you.

1 Corinthians 14:2  
(NIV)

[2] For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God. Indeed, no one understands him; he utters mysteries with his spirit.

1 Corinthians 14:4  
(NIV)

[4] He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself.....

## Jude 20 (AMP)

[20] But you, beloved, build yourselves up [founded] on your most holy faith [make progress, rise like an edifice higher and higher], praying in the Holy Spirit;
