#1) The Glory is already here. It manifests when the Holy Spirit is allowed to manifest. (The Glory is the manifestation of the Holy Spirit). For the Glory to Manifest in our lives we will need to know

a. Who we are and what authority we have as Believers according to the Word of God.

b. We will need to operate in our authority. This comes primarily through our Beliefs/Faith & the Words we Speak (Prayers of Authority).

#2) Sin will mess up the manifestation of the Glory. So to live in the fulness of authority that is available to us, we will need to deal with whatever sin in our lives that the Holy Spirit is talking to us about.

Colossians 1:27 (NKJV)

[27] To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

a. 'The Anointing in you, is the Joyful, Confident\Expectation of the Power and Presence of God Manifesting'.

b. When the Glory is Poured out, it Manifests in everyone.

[4] just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

[8] But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

[20] “I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

[25] Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, [26] that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, [27] that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.

"Then I passed by I said to you, Live! I made you grow like a plant of the field. You grew up and developed and became the most beautiful of jewels..... Later I passed by, and when I looked at you and saw that you were old enough for love, I spread the corner of my garment over you..... I gave you my solemn oath and entered into a covenant with you, declares the Sovereign LORD, and you became mine. I bathed you with water and washed..... you and put ointments on you. [5] Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, "The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously"? [6] But He gives more grace. Therefore, He says:

"God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

[7] Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. [8] Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. [9] Lament and mourn and weep! Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. [10] Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up.

(NKJV)

[26] Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, [27] to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. [28] And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!" [29] But when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was.

(NKJV)

[30] Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. [31] "And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS. [32] "He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. [33] "And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end." [34] Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?"

(NKJV)

[35] And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God. [36] "Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren. [37] "For with God nothing will be impossible." [38] Then Mary said, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.

(NKJV)

[39] Now Mary arose in those days and went into the hill country with haste, to a city of Judah, [40] and entered the house of Zacharias and greeted Elizabeth. [41] And it happened, when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, that the babe leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit.



Luke 1:56-57 ***(NKJV)***

[56] And Mary remained with her about three months, and returned to her house. [57] Now Elizabeth's full time came for her to be delivered, and she brought forth a son.
