1. Agape

2. Philadelphia

3. Phileo

4. Sometimes Eros. (But it's not found in the NT)

1.'Agapao'

a. It's more the 'state, condition, or mindset' of a person with Godly Love. a. It's used the most in the NT: approximately 117 times.

2. 'Agape'

a. It is referring more to taking Agapao, and living it out. Putting it into action.

b. It the one we think of the most when we think of the God's Kind of Love

c. It's used approximately 106 times in the NT

3. 'Philidelphia'

a. Based in Fraternal affection: brotherly Love; kindness; Love of the Brethren (church app)

b. Used 4 times in the NT

4. 'Phileo'

a. Used approximately 22 times in the NT

b. It is the love that most of the world and Christians operate in.

c. In itself, it's not bad - but it must be built on the foundation of Agapao / Agape to be good.

4. 'Phileo'

d. Phileo is being a friend / having affection for.....

- It tends to turn selfish and ungodly most of the time.
- It builds relationships on me, my feelings, my desires, how this relationship will serve me.

e. Interestingly, in my reference sources, it is the one pitted against Agape in that Phileo is the love that most Christians live in and think they are being Godly, Loving people. But in reality, it is not what God wants us living in..... **Agape**; One of the definitions:

A. Agape is the "Love that embraces truth". Example: 1 Cor. 13:4-8
 all references are Agape.

2. v. 6 - Love (Agape) "rejoices in the truth".

There are two things you can say for sure about human beings: our opposable thumbs make us great at using tools, and we are all big, fat liars. By age four, 90% of children have grasped the concept of lying, and it just gets worse from there.



According to a 2002 study conducted by Robert Feldman of the University of Massachusetts, 60% of adults can't have a tenminute conversation without lying at least once. But even that number makes it sound better than it really is; those people in the study who did lie actually told an average of 3 lies during their brief chat.

And I know you're sitting there right now insisting you would be part of the 40% who didn't lie.

That's what the liars in the study thought, too. When they watched the taped conversations back, they were shocked at how many fibs they had told. Nope. No way. Not me. We lie to everyone. Our parents get the worst of it, according to The Day America Told the Truth, with 86% of us lying to them regularly, followed by friends (75%), siblings (73%), and spouses (69%). But in general, we lie about things that aren't important, little things that we think will make us look better or more likeable.

For Centuries, psychologists, philosophers and students of human nature have been probing how and why humans lie. But it was only in the mid-1900s that the study of deception emerged as a subject of popular scientific inquiry.

From thousands of controlled scientific studies and the field research done during this relatively short period, researchers and criminal investigators have amassed a considerable body of knowledge about deception—and how to detect it.

Here are some of their most remarkable findings so far:

- Humans are lied to as many as 200 times a day.
- Humans detect lies with only 54% accuracy. Separate studies led by deception researchers Aldert Vrij and Bella DePaulo found that the overwhelming majority of lies went undetected.
- Of the lies we tell, 25% are for someone else's sake.
- Children begin deceiving as early as age 6 months.

- Percent of adults who admit to telling lies "sometimes" or "often" > 12 %
- Percent of women who admit to occasionally telling harmless half-truths > 80 %
- Percent of people who admit to lying on their resumes > 31 %
- Percent of patients who lie to their doctor > 13 %
- Percent of patients who "stretched the truth" to their doctor > 32 %
- Percent of patients who lied about following a doctors treatment plan > 40 %

- Percent of patients who lied about their diet and exercise regiments > 30 %
- Percent of people who lie at least once during a 10-minute conversation > 60 %
- Average number of lies per day by men to their partner, boss, or colleagues > 6
- Average number of lies/day by women to their partner, boss, or colleagues > 3
