Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. DESPISE - FEEL CONTEMPT OR DEEP REPUGNANCE FOR

CONTEMPT - THE FEELING THAT A PERSON OR THING IS BENEATH CONSIDERATION, WORTHLESS, OR DESERVING SCORN.

REPUGNANCE - INTENSE DISGUST

HONOR - HIGH RESPECT; GREAT ESTEEM, A TITLE OF RESPECT

DISHONOR - A STATE OF SHAME OR DISGRACE. DISGRACE - LOSS OF REPUTATION OR RESPECT - FALL FROM FAVOR OR LOSE POSITION OF POWER AND HONOR.

GRACE - THE FREE AND UNMERITED FAVOR OF GOD, AS MANIFESTED IN SALVATION AND THE BESTOWAL OF THE BLESSINGS. THE CONDITION OR FACT OF BEING FAVORED BY SOMEONE.

ITS ONLY THRU THE BLOOD OF JESUS THAT WE CAN BE ESTABLISHED IN FAVOR.

STRIVE - MAKE GREAT EFFORTS OR ACHIEVE OR OBTAIN SOMETHING, FIGHT VIGOROUSLY, STRUGGLE.
