Ephesians 4:1-2

Therefore, the prisoner for the Lord, appeal to and beg you to walk (lead a life) worthy of the divine calling to which you have been called (with behavior that is a credit to the summons to God's service, Living as becomes you with complete lowliness of mind, (humility) and meekness (unselfishness, gentleness, mildness,) with patience, bearing with one another and making allowances because you love one another.

Acts 26:16 (amp)

Get up and stand on your feet. I have appeared to you for this purpose, to appoint you (to serve) as a minister and as a witness (to testify, with authority) not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you.

Psalm 42:7

Exodus 20:20

Moses said to the people, “Do not be afraid; for God has come in order to test you, and order that the fear of Him (that is, a profound reverence for Him) will remain with you, so that you do not sin.”

Proverbs 2:1-5

My son, if you will receive my words and treasure my commandments within you, so that your ear is attentive to (skillful and godly) wisdom, and apply you heart to understanding (seeking it conscientiously and striving for it eagerly) Yes if you cry out for insight and lift up your voice for understanding; If you seek skillful and godly wisdom as you would silver and search for her as you would hidden treasures; Then you will understand the (reverent) fear of the Lord, (that is, worshiping Him and regarding Him as truly awesome) and discover the knowledge of God.
