Hearken: To listen, or to hear

Romans 10:17

So faith comes from hearing (what is told) and hearing by the preaching of the message concerning Christ.

The Old Testament

Seeing thru signs and the Father spoke, Prophets spoke The New Testament

Jesus spoke - repeating what was already said, speaking in the now

and prophesying the future.

Then He gave us the power to do the same.

Then He commanded us to GO into all the world and preach (speak)

So the formula is the WORD and the SPIRIT.

To receive anything from the salvation power of God The Formula is:

We hear from God thru the written word, the spoken word.

We choose to believe then our speaking lines up with what He spoke.

Then we say what He says and the Spirit empowers the whole thing.

Believing activates Faith and manifests the operation of the Spirit.

Luke 5:12 thru 13



Proverbs 4:20 - 22


