1 Peter 2:22 (AMP)

[22] He was guilty of no sin, neither was deceit (guile) ever found on His lips. [Isa 53:9.]

John 14:30-
31 (AMP)

[30] I will not talk with you much more, for the prince (evil genius, ruler) of the world is coming. And he has no claim on Me. [He has nothing in common with Me; there is nothing in Me that belongs to him, and he has no power over Me.]

[31] But [Satan is coming and] I do as the Father has commanded Me, so that the world may know (be convinced) that I love the Father and that I do only what the Father has instructed Me to do. [I act in full agreement with His orders.] Rise, let us go away from here.

John 10:17-
18 (AMP)

[17] For this [reason] the Father loves Me, because I lay down My [own] life — to take it back again.

[18] No one takes it away from Me. On the contrary, I lay it down voluntarily. [I put it from Myself.] I am authorized and have power to lay it down (to resign it) and I am authorized and have power to take it back again. These are the instructions (orders) which I have received [as My charge] from My Father.



The biggest things we need to know to get free and stay free of Demonic issues are:

- What is our Authority?
- Stay out of willful sin

1 John 3:8 (AMP)

[8] [But] he who commits sin [who practices evildoing] is of the devil [takes his character from the evil one], for the devil has sinned (violated the divine law) from the beginning. The reason the Son of God was made manifest (visible) was to undo (destroy, loosen, and dissolve) the works the devil [has done].

Luke 11:14-
17 (NKJV)

[14] And He was casting out a demon, and it was mute. So it was, when the demon had gone out, that the mute spoke; and the multitudes marveled. [15] But some of them said, “He casts out demons by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons.” [16] Others, testing Him, sought from Him a sign from heaven. [17] But He, knowing their thoughts, said to them: “Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation, and a house divided against a house falls.”

John 16:8 (NKJV)

[8] “And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

John 16:11 (NKJV)

[11] “of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.”



Luke 10:19 (NKJV)

[19] “Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

1 John 3:4-10
(NKJV)

[4] Whoever commits {Amp: "practices"} sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness. [5] And you know that He was manifested to take away our sins, and in Him there is no sin. [6] Whoever abides in Him does not sin {Amp: "deliberately, knowingly, habitually practices sin"}. Whoever {Amp: "Habitually"} sins has neither seen Him nor known Him.

[7] Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous.

[8] He who sins {Amp: “practices evil doing”} is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. [9] Whoever has been born of God does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of God.

[10] In this the children of God and the children of the devil are manifest.....

To get free from Demonic Activity - Submit to God:

1) Deal with Willful Sin:

- a. Acknowledge it.
- b. Confess and Repent.

1 John 1:9 (NKJV)

[9] If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Acts 3:19 (NKJV)

[19] "Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord,

Address Generational Sin (for Patterns in Family)

2) Resist the Devil.

James 4:7 (NKJV)

[7] Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

From G473 and G2476 ; to stand against, that is, oppose:—resist, withstand.

G473 (A root word for G436)

A primary particle; opposite, that is, instead or because of (rarely in addition to):—for, in the room of. Often used in composition to denote contrast, requital, substitution, correspondence, etc.

a. Part of Resisting: Binding and Loosing

Matthew 16:19 (AMP)

[19] I will give you the keys (authority) of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind [forbid, declare to be improper and unlawful] on earth [a]will have [already] been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose [permit, declare lawful] on earth [b]will have [already] been loosed in heaven.”

b. Part of Resisting - Speak to them

Luke 4:35 (NKJV)

[35] But Jesus rebuked him, saying, “Be quiet, and come out of him!” And when the demon had thrown him in their midst, it came out of him and did not hurt him.

Luke 4:41 (NKJV)

[41] And demons also came out of many, crying out and saying, “You are the Christ, the Son of God!” And He, rebuking them, did not allow them to speak, for they knew that He was the Christ.

Matthew 8:16 (NKJV)

[16] When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick,
