## Placing a High Value

### Honor - G5091 (Strong's)

**“from 5093; to prize, i.e. fix a valuation upon; by implication, to revere:--honor, value.”**

### Honor - G5091 (Thayer's)

**“to estimate, to fix the value; mid. to fix the value of something belonging to one's self”**

## Honor - H3513 (Strong's)

**“or kabed {kaw-bade'}; a primitive root; to be heavy, i.e. in a bad sense (burdensome, severe, dull) or in a good sense (numerous, rich, honorable; causatively, to make weighty)”**

## Honor - H3519 (Strong's)

**“... from 3513; properly, weight, but only figuratively in a good sense, splendor or copiousness:--glorious(-ly), glory, honour(-able).”**

## **Some of my own thoughts on placing a High Value:**

- We spend time on it / with it.**
- We take care of it.**
- It has a high priority in our lives.**
- We “revere” it / the person.**

**(Webster: “to show devoted deferential honor to : regard as worthy of great honor”)**
