## Prosperity

Genesis 26:12-14 (AMP) – "Then Isaac sowed seed in that land and received in the same year a hundred times as much as he had planted, and the Lord favored him with blessings. And the man became great and gained more and more until he became very wealthy and distinguished; He owned flocks, herds, and a great supply of servants, and the Philistines envied him."

**Genesis 30:43** – "...And the man increased exceedingly, and had much cattle, and maidservants, and menservants, and camels, and donkeys."

**Isaiah 1:19** – "If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land..."

**Psalm 35:27 (AMP)** – "Let those who favor my righteous cause and have pleasure in my uprightness shout for joy and be glad and say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, who takes pleasure in the <u>prosperity</u> of His servant."
