


Why I believe they're wrong.

Matthew 24:36-42 (NIV)

Global Missions Face Urgent Task: 3.4 Billion Still Unreached by the Gospel

Over 6,000 of these unreached people groups are located inside the 10/40 Window, a rectangular area spanning from West Africa to East Asia between 10 and 40 degrees north latitude.

It is estimated that of the 8.08 billion people alive in the world today, 3.42 billion of them live in unreached people groups with little or no access to the Gospel of Jesus Christ, representing 42.4% of the global population. This massive unreached population presents one of the greatest challenges facing Christian missions in the 21st century.

This massive unreached population presents one of the greatest challenges facing Christian missions in the 21st century.

Defining the Unreached

Over 3 billion people in over 7,000 people groups are currently unreached by the Gospel. Unreached peoples and places are those among whom Jesus is largely unknown and the church is relatively insufficient to make Jesus known in its broader community. There's an estimated 7,290 unreached people groups in the world, meaning there are no indigenous Christians Living within the community.

The 10/40 Window Concentration

Over 6,000 of these unreached people groups are located inside the 10/40 Window, a rectangular area spanning from West Africa to East Asia between 10 and 40 degrees north latitude. There are currently over 7,400 unreached people groups worldwide, representing roughly 3.37 billion people, with the highest concentration in this strategic region.
