

Watchman on the Wall

Spiritual Watchman

- Staying alert
- Receiving revelations
- Engaging in intercessional prayer
- Climb the spiritual tower, stand on their watch post, and taking their assignment seriously
- Protect the spiritual “hive” as well as welcoming the lost
- Addresses situations with biblical truths
- Cultivates a deep relationship with God through prayer and fasting
- Jevhovah Nissi (the Lord our banner; the Lord our victory. Standard)
- “On your walls, O Jerusalem, I have appointed and stationed watchmen (prophets), Who will never keep silent day or night; You who profess the Lord, take no rest for yourselves, And give Him no rest [from your prayers] until He establishes Jerusalem And makes her a praise on the earth.” Isaiah 62:6-7 AMP

Climbing the Tower

- Gains vision and revelations from God
- Moving beyond everyday life to higher spiritual perspective to see into deeper things and gain understandings of God's plans and purposes
- Through prayer, fasting, and maturity - station on the tower to receive divine insight and wisdom for the future
- Jehovah Oze [Awz] (I Am the Lord who is your strength - power/might)
- ““I love You [fervently and devotedly], O Lord, my strength.” The Lord is my rock,

my fortress, and the One who rescues me; My God, my rock and strength in whom I trust and take refuge; My shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower—my stronghold.” Psalms 18:1-2 AMP

Willing Heart

- Have a willing heart to receive God's blessings and authority
- Willing and obedient to climb the tower and align with God's will
- Willing to pray and fast so that fear can be overcome, confront issues, and seek the secret things God has in store
- Jehovah Qadash (I am the Lord who sanctifies you)
- “So now finish this, so that your eagerness in desiring it may be equaled

by your completion of it, according to your ability. For if the eagerness [to give] is there, it is acceptable according to what one has, not according to what he does not have.” 2 Corinthians 8:11-12 AMP

Peace of a Watchman

- Regulated by God's peace in order to sense, discern, and pray effectively
- Have peace so we can have order, clarity, and conviction
- Leads to a deeper understanding of God's will and His presence in our lives
- Jevhovah Shalom (the Lord our peace; perfect, full, to pay or render)
- "And the peace of God [that peace which reassures the heart, that peace]

which transcends all understanding, [that peace which] stands guard over your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus [is yours]." Philippians 4:7 AMP

Your Guard Post

- Reveal our spiritual station to guard, pray, and watch over
- Consistently show up in our zone so we can operate in our gifting
- Governmental, family, prophetic, deliverance, healing, or others
- Faithful to our station, pray for discernment, and operate in our designated area of spiritual responsibility
- Jevhovah Jireh (The Lord will see or provide; the Revealin; one who is more than a provider. The Lord will see to it)
- "that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the

Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints," Ephesians 1:17-18 ESV
