 - 4. (Gr.) - Despotes - "Absolute Ruler, Master, Lord."

- G. Son

To help us so that we don't forget some of the basic differentiating characteristics of the trinity, below is a restating of some of the information which was listed in the first booklet.

The Father: He is the Source of everything. He is the one ultimately in control. He is the supreme authority in the Trinity. The Son and Holy Spirit answer to the Father. He is the one who sets the Destiny of ALL things. He is the ultimate originator of ALL things. He takes care of the overall picture of ALL Life. Covenants are made with the Father. He is the one planning, working, and bringing to pass everything in the Trinity's destiny for our lives.

The Son: He is the Savior. He is the one who has established the covenant between man and the Father. He is the direction giver from the Father to the Holy Spirit. He is the mediator/intercessor between man and the Father. He is the Baptizer with the Holy Spirit. He is the Head of the church. He carries the government of His church and of this world on His shoulders. He is the Problem Resolver between the Father and man. It is through Christ

that everything flows from the Father to man, and Vice/
Versa.

The Holy Spirit: He is the one actively at work on this earth with man. He is the one who literally is with us at all times. He is the one who lives with us and in us. He is the Counselor/Comforter/Helper. He is the one who applies what Jesus says the Father desires. He is the one who helps us perform what the Father desires. He is the one who habitually speaks with us, teaches us, leads us, works with us, and ministers to us/through us according to what the Father desires.

C. The Living Word.

1. The "Word" refers to Christ. (John 1:1,14 Rev.19:13) Before He came to this earth and was given the name "Jesus", He was known as the "Word". This proves His eternal Pre-Existence. (Micah 5:1-2, Rev. 1:8,11, 2:8, 22:13-16) He is an eternal being as the Father and the Holy Spirit. (Ps. 90:1-2, Heb. 9:14)
2. Not only was the "Word" with God, but He was God, and will always be as much divine and the other two members of the trinity. (Ps. 45:6-7, Is. 9:6-7, John 1:1, Heb. 1:8-12, Rev. 1:8,11, 22:13-16)
3. In the New Testament you will find two Greek words for "Word" in the KJV. (a) Logos. Often seems to refer to past tense type of speaking, etc. It Deals with a concept, idea, speech, something spoken, reason, instruction, decree, mandate, order, a saying, etc. - that have been spoken in the past or have been written down. Also refers to Jesus. (John 1:1) (b) Rhema. Deals more with the current/present expression of the logos. It is that which is or has been uttered by the living voice, thing spoken, any sound produced by the voice and having a definite meaning. (Source: Thayer's Greek/English Lexicon)

F. The Three Eternal Estates of Jesus.
