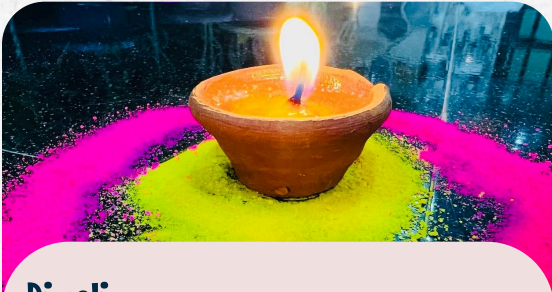
Maha Shivratri

Growing older, this festival climbs to the top of my list. As a Kashmiri Pandit I've come to feel more deeply each year the purity and meaning of Herath (our way of celebrating Maha Shivratri). This is not just a festival as our community has done for centuries it is our culture, our responsibility.

In our home the house is cleaned with care, cousins gather, and we recreate the sacred marriage of Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati. Father and mother lead the pooja, fasting through the day, then placing special metal pots representing Shiva and Parvati in the puja hall. We invite the ganas & God (Ganesha) too, then cook, feed them first and distribute sacred walnuts soaked in the pot as prashad. And after the ceremony, the younger ones receive a small gift from elders called "herath karch" an old-loved joyful tradition.

No matter where we are in the world, this festival brings me home. It reminds me of belonging, continuity, and the sacred bond our ancestors. Har Har Mahadev!

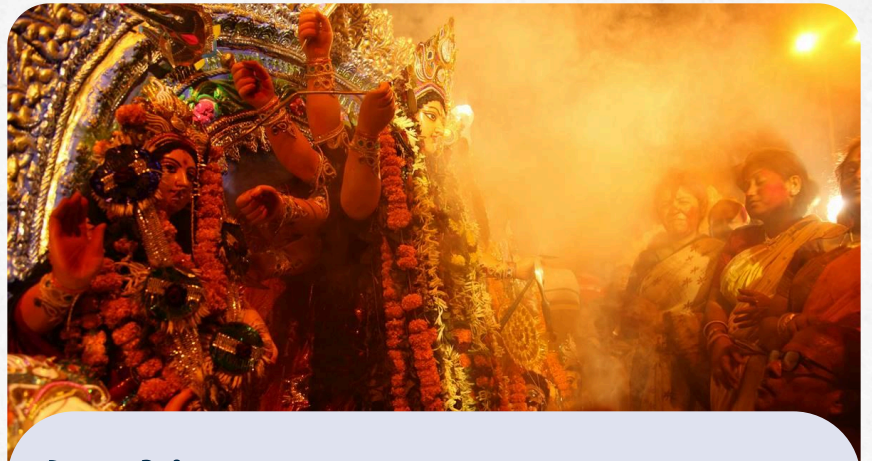

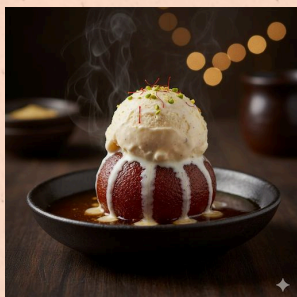
