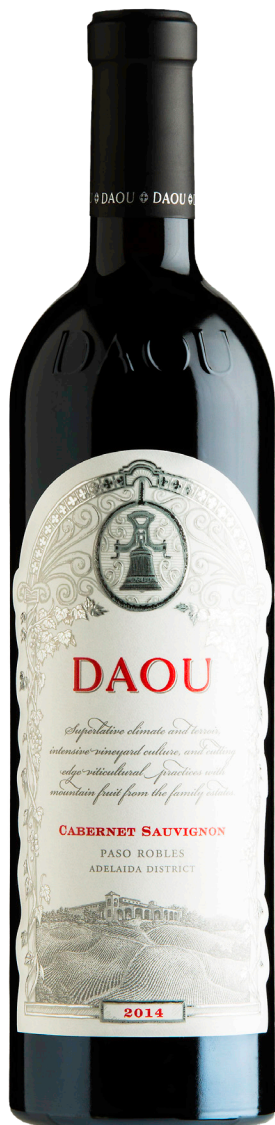

**THE WINE** | This powerful yet elegant wine displays heady aromatics of black raspberry and cassis fruits, toasted bread, Vanilla bean and hints of licorice. Full bodied with a perfect and seamless integration of tannins, this wine is broad on palate with a long finish that is every expansive. The integration of the fruit, the tannins and the acidity shows the harmony present in this beautiful nectar. The experience is never disconnected and carries beautiful symmetry from the moment the wine hits your palate until long after. A well-built Cabernet Sauvignon showing ideal varietal character and what can be accomplished on DAOU Mountain in a blockbuster vintage.

A big step up is the 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon Estate, which is 100% varietal and sees 20 months in new French oak. Its 14.7% alcohol isn't noticeable in the least and it's a rich, full-bodied, concentrated Cabernet that gives up notions of creme de cassis, licorice, sweet oak and smoked herbs. Layered, sexy and voluptuous, with a great finish, drink it anytime over the coming decade or so.
