WHAT IS COWORKING?

Definition: Shared workspaces providing flexible, collaborative environments for professionals

Origins: Emerged in early 2000s, with rapid global growth since 2010

Key Features: Hot desks, private offices, meeting rooms, and community spaces

Target Users: Freelancers, startups, remote workers, and enterprise teams



MARKET TRENDS

Global coworking market growing at 15% CAGR

Over 35,000 coworking spaces worldwide

30% of professionals in major cities use
coworking

Market projected to reach \$50B by 2028



BENEFITS OF COWORKING SPACES

- Flexibility: short-term leases and 24/7 access
- Networking: connect with diverse professionals
- Cost-efficiency: shared resources reduce overhead
- Productivity: inspiring environments, fewer distractions

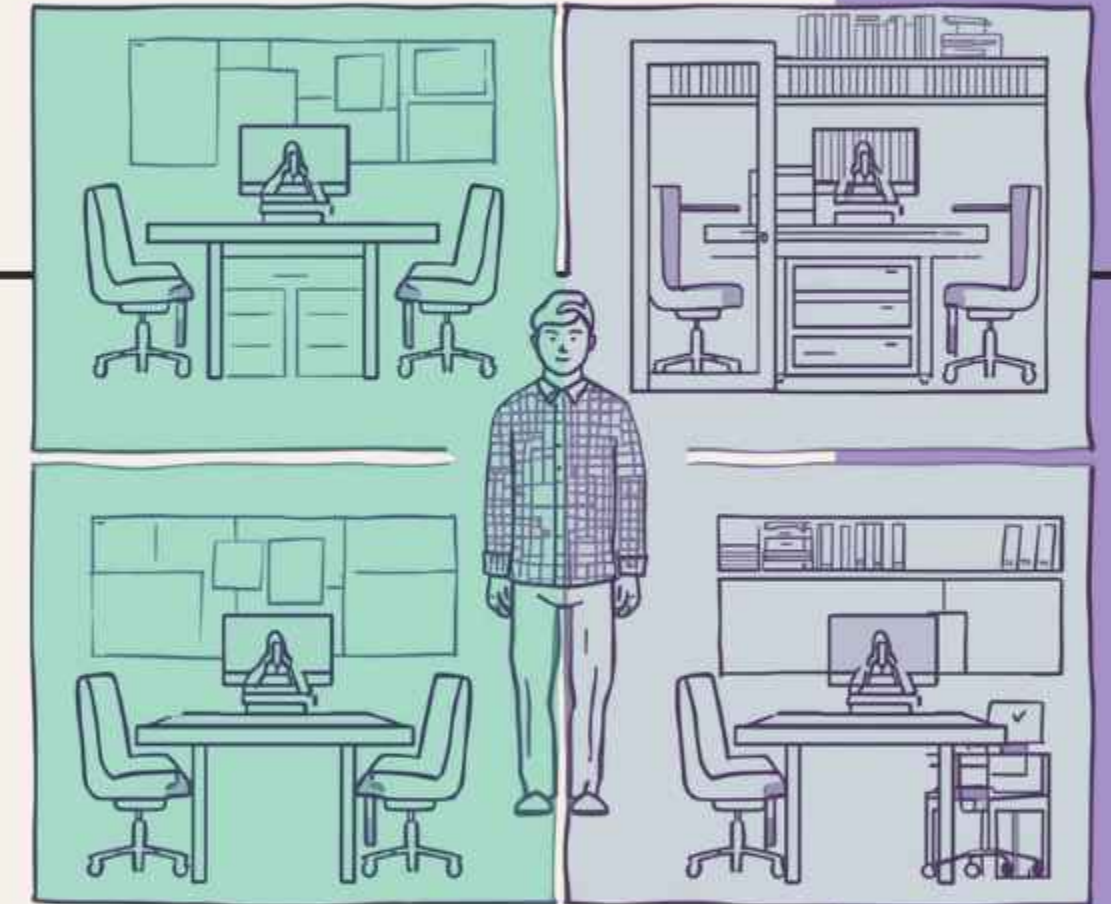
TYPES OF COWORKING SPACES

Open coworking areas: flexible desks in shared environments

Private offices: dedicated spaces within coworking facilities

Niche spaces: industry-specific hubs and startup incubators

Hybrid models: combining remote work with on-site access
