

Simple Guide to RJ60 Which City It Represents and RTO Details

When checking a Rajasthan vehicle registration number, the first two letters indicate the state, while the following digits help identify the registration jurisdiction. If you are searching for [rj60 which city](#), the code is associated with Jaipur, Rajasthan, specifically an additional Jaipur registration jurisdiction. The Rajasthan Transport Department's official registration information lists RJ-60 along with RJ-14 and RJ-45 under Jaipur-I.

What Does RJ60 Mean?

RJ60 is a vehicle registration code used in Rajasthan. Here, RJ represents Rajasthan, while 60 identifies a particular registration jurisdiction under the state transport system.

A typical registration number may look like:

RJ 60 AB 1234

The different parts indicate:

RJ: Rajasthan state code

60: RTO registration code

AB: Registration series

1234: Unique vehicle number

The code helps identify the transport authority under which a vehicle has been registered. It can be useful when checking vehicle documents, understanding registration details or identifying the registration jurisdiction from a number plate.

RJ60 Which City Does It Represent?

The answer to rj60 which city is Jaipur.

RJ60 is associated with the Jaipur region as an additional Jaipur registration code. The Rajasthan Transport Department's official vehicle-registration information groups RJ-60 with Jaipur-I along with RJ-14 and RJ-45.

This means that seeing RJ60 on a vehicle's registration plate generally indicates that the vehicle is registered within the Jaipur transport jurisdiction associated with this code.

It is important to distinguish the registration code from the vehicle owner's current residential location. A vehicle carrying an RJ60 number does not necessarily mean that the owner currently lives in the exact area where the vehicle was originally registered.

Why Does Jaipur Have Multiple RTO Codes?

Jaipur is a major urban and administrative centre of Rajasthan, so vehicle-registration responsibilities are distributed across different transport jurisdictions.

The Rajasthan Transport Department's official list includes several Jaipur-related codes, including RJ-14, RJ-45 and RJ-60.

Multiple registration codes can help transport authorities organise vehicle registration and related services according to different jurisdictions. Therefore, finding different RJ codes on vehicles in Jaipur does not necessarily indicate that they belong to different states or unrelated regions.

Major RTO Services Related to RJ60

The RTO performs several functions connected with vehicle owners and drivers. Depending on the specific service and jurisdiction, these may include:

New vehicle registration

Issuing registration certificates

Transfer of vehicle ownership

Updating vehicle registration details

Issuing and renewing driving licences

Learner's licence-related services

Road tax-related procedures

Vehicle fitness certification

Permit-related services for applicable vehicles

Issuing duplicate registration certificates

Updating address and other vehicle information

Hypothecation addition or removal

Vehicle-related documentation and verification

Many transport services can now be initiated or accessed through online government platforms, although certain procedures may still require the applicant to visit the relevant RTO.

Vehicle Registration Under RJ60

When purchasing a new vehicle in Jaipur, registration is an important legal requirement. The dealer generally assists with the registration process, while the transport authority processes the registration according to the applicable rules.

The registration process can broadly involve:

Purchase of the vehicle from an authorised dealer.

Submission of the required vehicle and purchaser documents.

Payment of applicable registration charges and taxes.

Verification of vehicle and ownership details.

Assignment of the registration number.

Issuance of the Registration Certificate.

The exact requirements, fees and process may vary according to the vehicle category and applicable government rules.

Documents Generally Required for Vehicle Registration

Vehicle owners may need several documents during registration or related RTO procedures. Commonly requested documents can include:

Proof of identity

Proof of address

Vehicle sale invoice

Form-related registration documents

Insurance certificate

Pollution Under Control (PUC) certificate, where applicable

Temporary registration details, if applicable

Road tax payment details

Vehicle-related dealer documents

Applicants should verify the latest document requirements before visiting the transport office because requirements can differ according to the service and vehicle type.

Why Is the RJ60 Code Important?

An RTO code is more than a number printed on a vehicle plate. It helps connect the vehicle registration with the relevant transport jurisdiction.

For vehicle owners, understanding RJ60 can be useful when:

Checking registration information

Understanding the registration jurisdiction

Completing vehicle-related paperwork

Applying for ownership transfer

Handling registration certificate-related work

Checking vehicle documentation

Understanding the RTO associated with a number plate

It can also help buyers of used vehicles understand where a vehicle was originally registered.

RJ60 and Used Vehicle Purchases

If you are considering buying a second-hand vehicle carrying an RJ60 registration, the registration code alone should not be used to judge the vehicle's condition or ownership history.

Before purchasing a used vehicle, check important details such as:

Registration Certificate

Insurance validity

PUC status

Chassis and engine numbers

Ownership details

Pending loans or hypothecation

Tax status

Previous accident or damage history

Service and maintenance records

The registration number can help identify the vehicle's registration jurisdiction, but a proper document and vehicle inspection is essential before completing the transaction.

RJ60 vs Other Jaipur Registration Codes

Jaipur has more than one registration code. For example, the Rajasthan Transport Department's official list identifies RJ-14, RJ-45 and RJ-60 in connection with Jaipur-I.

RTO Code	Associated Area
RJ-14	Jaipur
RJ-45	Jaipur (North)
RJ-60	Jaipur additional registration jurisdiction

The exact administrative use of individual codes can change as transport jurisdictions are reorganised. Therefore, vehicle owners should rely on current transport department information when a specific RTO office or service jurisdiction is important.

Important Things to Remember About RJ60

If you come across an RJ60 vehicle number, keep these points in mind:

RJ60 is a Rajasthan registration code.

RJ60 is associated with Jaipur.

The code identifies a registration jurisdiction rather than the owner's current location.

Jaipur has multiple registration codes.

RTO services cover vehicle registration, licences, taxes and other transport-related matters.

Vehicle owners should keep their RC, insurance and other mandatory documents updated.

Requirements and procedures may change, so current official transport information should be checked before completing an RTO process.
